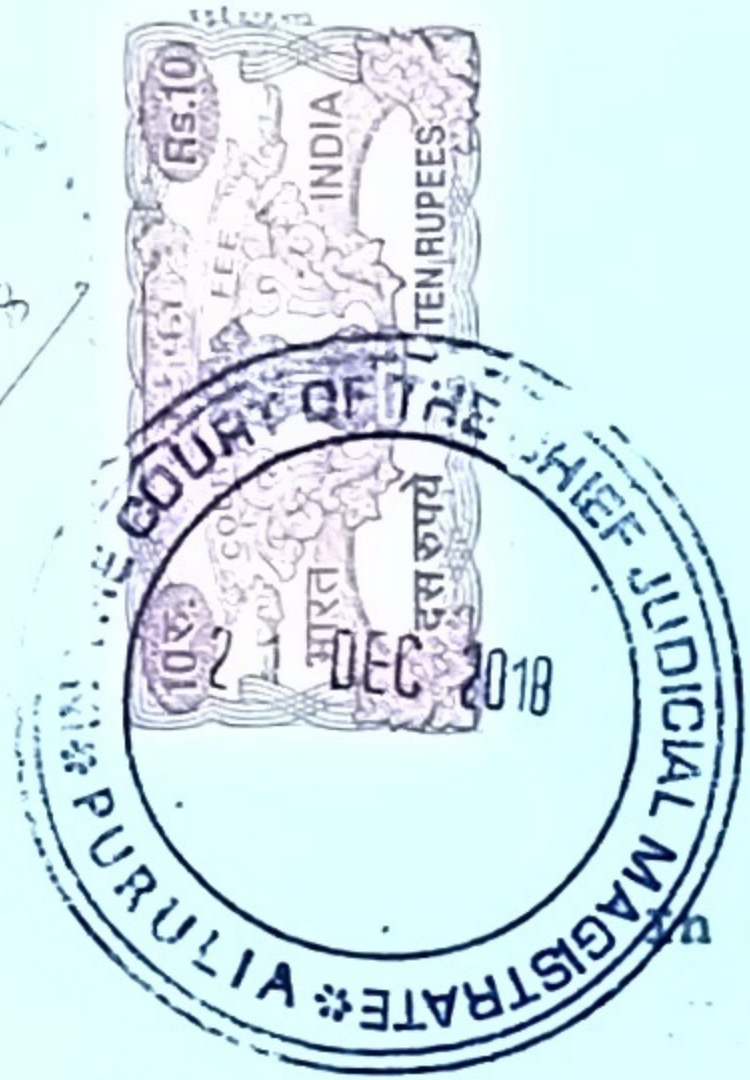

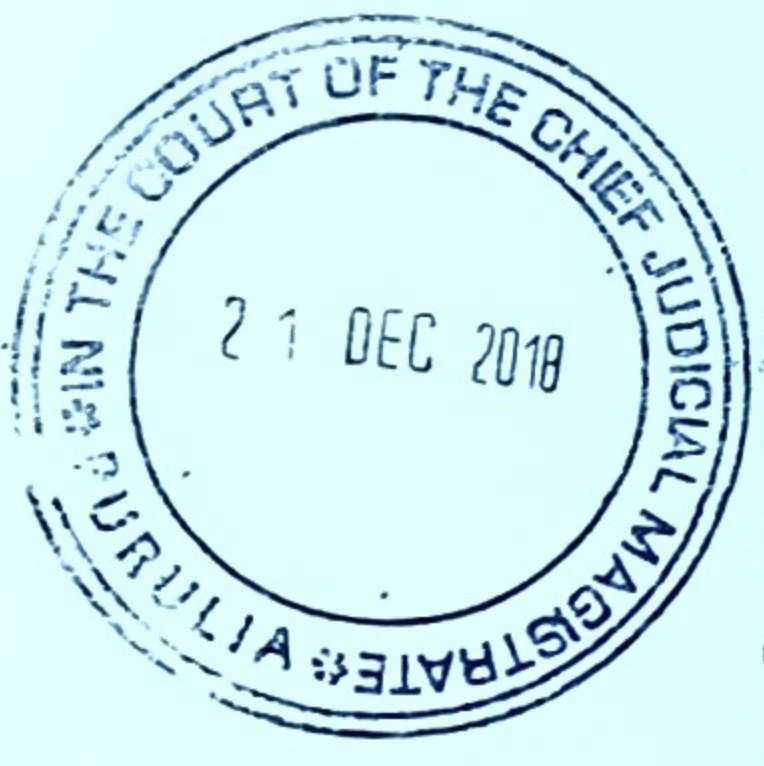

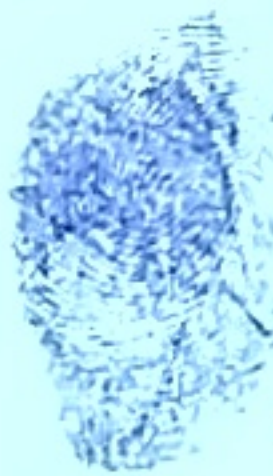
The above named complainant

Begs to state as follows :-

1. That the complainant is the legally married wife of the accused person No.1 and their marriage was solemnised and took place on 14th Jyastha '14/5' B.S. corresponding to (28th day of May) 2008 according to Hindu rites and customs prevailing in their community. The marriage in between the complainant and accused person No.1 was consummated and their marriage tie still subsists.

2. That at the time of marriage of the complainant the father of the complainant was compelled to give Rs. 45,000/- (Rupees forty five thousand) only in cash, some utensils and furnitures, the value of which was Rs. 50,000/- (Rupees fifty thousand) only to the accused persons No. 1 to 4 as per their demand. Apart from that the father of the complainant was incurred, Rs. 50,000/- (Rupees fifty thousand) only for feast and for other expenses of marriage.

5. That after marriage the complainant had been to the house of the accused person No.1 and lived there as husband and wife.

4. That after some days of the marriage of the complainant the accused No.1 and at the active aid and abetment of the accused persons No.2 to 4 pressurised to the complainant to bring Rs. 20,000/- (Rupees twenty thousand only) from her father's house. The complainant narrated the illegal demand of <sup>father</sup> dowry by the accused persons 1 to 4 to her father but the father of the complainant unable to pay the same due to his <sup>poverty</sup> poverty. Then due to non-fulfilment of further demand <sup>of</sup> dowry the accused ~~persons~~ persons 1 to 4 and the active aid and abetment of ~~the~~ the accused No.5 started tortured upon the complainant both physically and mentally and in various ways. The accused No. 1 to 4 did not provide sufficient meals and cloths to the complainant, on the contrary the accused persons No. 1 to 4 assaulted upon the complainant off and on by fists and blows and by lathi without any reasons on her part. However the complainant accepted such tortures and was compelled to stay at her matrimonial home with hope that the accused No.1 would change his mind in future but it was on vain.

5. That due to non giving birth of any child the act of cruelty upon the complainant by the accused persons was increasing day by day and that she was denied of all the necessities and that the accused person No.1 used to assault the complainant off and on with the intention that the complainant ~~kk~~ will either

either have to commit suicide or to leave her matrimonial home.

6. That the complainant narrated the incident to her parents and other witnesses while she used to come at her father's house and then they assured the complainant to live at her matrimonial home with hope that the matter will be solved in future and then she returned back to her matrimonial home but the act of cruelty was continuing for about 9 (Nine) years.

7. That few days before in the last day of Chaitra last year the accused Nos. 1 and 4 assaulted to the complainant mercilessly and the accused No. 4 assaulted to the complainant by fists and blows to her mouth and as a result of which her teeth was broken and drove her out from her matrimonial home and she took shelter at cowshed during whole night and on the next day she took shelter at her father's house and thereafter she treated there at Hospital.

8. That thereafter the accused No. 1 brought the complainant to her house with assurance that she would maintain her properly and will not torture upon her further, <sup>some</sup> ~~but~~ ~~soon~~ days later the accused persons No. 1 to 4 started torture again like previous manner and on 18th Ashwin 1425 B.S. the accused Nos. 1 to 4 with active aid and abatement of accused No. 5 in collusion with each other assaulted to the complainant and drove her out from her matrimonial home and then no other alternative the complaint <sup>-and</sup> was compelled to take shelter at her

father's house and since then she has been living at her father's house.

9. That the complainant waited till 03/11/2018 with hope that the accused No.1 will bring back her to her matrimonial home but it was on vain and then on 04/11/2018 the complainant reported the matter to I.C. Joypur P.S. by registered Post with A/D, but the Police did not take any action against the accused persons and then the complainant no other alternative reported the matter to the Superintendent of Police, Purulia on 15/11/2018 but of no good and as such the complainant has compelled to lodge this complaint before this Ld. Court today.

10. That the accused No.1 is the husband, the accused No.2 is the father-in-law, the accused person No.3 is the mother-in-law, and the accused No.4 is the Deower of the complainant and the accused No.5 is the near relative of husband of the complainant.

11. That thus all the accused persons in collusion with each other and in furtherance of their common intention have committed offence punishable u/s- 498A/323/34 I.P.C.

It is, therefore, prayed that your Honour will be graciously pleased to send this complaint to the I.C. Joypur P.S. for investigation treating the same as an F.I.R. under Section 156(3) Cr.P.C. for the ends of justice.
