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Offence Committed Under Section :-

The humble petition on behalf
of the above named Petitioner/
Complainant ;

Most respectfully sheweth :-

1) _____ That, on 21/03/2017 the Complainant was engaged himself in the repairing work of our boundary walls. At about 10.00 A.M. when the work in question was on progress his neighbour one Garapada Kumar, 2) Jatu Kumar, 3) Juhnu Kumar all sons of Late Runku Kumar, 4) Swapan Kumar son of Jitnu Kumar and 5) Subhash Kumar son of Ritu Kumar all in drunken condition armed with deadly weapons like Lathi, Farse, Axe, Iron Rod etc, forming an unlawful assembly had been beside the house of the complainant and started hurrying abusive languages aiming at the Complainant and his inmates.

2) _____ That, the Complainant/your Petitioner then requested those miscreant not to pass such unparliamentary words and in reply said Garapada Kumar inflicted assault upon the Complainant with the blunt side (wooden handle) of the Axe in his hand, resultantly the Complainant sustained bleeding injury on his forehead. Thereafter the accused person No. 4 namely - Swapan Kumar dashed your Petitioner with the Iron Rod in his head putting the same on his chest followed by his falling down straight on the earth for which he sustained bleeding injury. on the posterior side of his head when the

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very vital part was dashed with the stones lying on the ground. He then raised alarm and then the Pitu's son viz. Subhas Kumar the another member of the said unlawful assembly happens to be the accused person No. 5 asked loudly his other companions to Kill/murder if the Complainant (Betsako prane marfall) taking the advantage of ~~malprasa~~ helplessness and the accused No. 3 Jithu Kumar at once carried out the verdict of of the accused No. 5 ~~by way of trying to~~ and tried to inflict assault upon Your Petitioner. But fortunately the witness No. 2, the father of the Complainant who meanwhile came out from their house hearing the he and cry of Your Petitioner restrain him by way of pulling his hand from back side.

3) _____ That, the Complainant and his father, the ~~witness~~ witness No. 2 both were then crying for help. Hearing which the co-villagers, remained nearby started arriving to the place of occurrence and seeing them to cause the accused persons fled away.

4) _____ That, the accused person No. 1 said Garu-da at the time of fleeing away fell down on the earth first in intoxicated condition, thereafter he started running again with the other Co-accuseds.

5) _____ That, the witness No. 3 the brother of Your Petitioner namely Santosh Kumar at the time of incident was not at their house the then had been to their cultivable land near river for supplying water

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to the growing vegetables. He on hearing such incident from his co-villagers rushed to the P.O. and with the help of the Co-Villagers present there took the Complainant and his father to the Bagundi/ Pethandi S.P.H.C., where the bleeding wounds of the Complainant were repaired by way of providing at least 7 stitches in total. Had he not be taken to the hospital in time he would have to face a premature death for sustains ~~the~~ in the injuries as mentioned above.

4) That, your petitioner/The Complainant then was referred to the Deben Mahato Seder Hospital. Puralle by the attending Medical Officer for better Medical management, wherein the M.O. on duty advised him for having certain clinical investigation and the reports of such investigations reveals that the Complainant also sustained fracture injury on (fracture in frontal bone involving the left the bony portion of the scalp/~~and after necessary~~ ~~checking for two consecutive days the attending~~ ~~medical officers advised to give the further~~ ~~ambulatory treatment of your petitioner~~ orbital margin with scalp haematoma over ~~line~~ lying the fracture and after necessary check up for two consecutive days the attending medical officers pleased to opine that further institutional treatment of your petitioner would be required continuously in any higher centre, but alas due to the indigent plight it could not be possible for your petitioner to proceed elsewhere for having better treatment, rather he started passing days with unbearable pain and agony in his house in -

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bed-ridden condition and the witness No.2 started visiting the respective houses of their relatives and wellwisher for borrowing money therefrom for providing atleast a proper though delayed treatment to his elder brother i.e. the Complainant.

7)_____ That, the witness No.2, Sri Sankar Kumar time and again had been to Begundi P.S., for lodging the information in writing before the O/C, concerned for lodging the law in motion, but the Officer on duty refused even to accept any written Complaint from him over the issue, rather on 03/04/2017 the Police personnel of Miss out post under Begundi P.S., arrested the Complainant along with his father and forwarded them to the L.C. Court on 04/04/2017.

8)_____ That, after obtaining the order of bail from the L.C. Court of Sessions, Pudukkottai when the Complainant was released by your Honour on furnishing bond he had been to the Begundi P.S. once again and requested for starting a specific Case against the accused persons, but it is of great regret that the Police personnel of Begundi P.S. on that occasion pronounced that in case of his further arrival at said P.S. Compound he would again be put behind the bar and in this time his wife, wife of his brother, brother Sankar would not also be spared.

9)_____ That, your Petitioner then on 02/05/2017 knocked the door of S.P., Pudukkottai, but even on receipt of a written allegation so levelled against all the accused persons specifically the district

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Police administration, too turned deaf ears to the same.

10) That, Your Petitioner being a hapless rustic villager having no handsome annual income is not in a position to incur the expenses of a Compl-int case more over search and seizure is very much required.

In light of the above it is therefore prayed that, your Honour may graciously be pleased to forward the instant petition of Complaint to the Officer-In-Charge of Rajmunda P.S. with a direction upon him to investigate into the case treating the same as an F.I.R. under the provisions so contemplated under section 156(1) Cr.P.Code.
