The complainant named above begs to state as follows:-

1. That the complainant is the legally married wife of the accused no. 1, Sikar Lohar and their marriage was solemnised on 27th day of Baishakh 2015 according to their customary rites and formalities prevailing in their community. The parties are Hindus by religion. After marriage they lived together as husband and wife at village nowadish under p. n. Begumundi. The marital tie between the parties is still subsisting.
2. That the complainant is the legally married wife of the accused no. 1 and other accused persons are her close relation, such as father-in-law and mother-in-law. Practically accused no. 3 is the head of the family and he works are the last words in the family.
3. That at the time of marriage the father of the complainant gave Rs. 80,000/- in cash as dowry and golden ornament 3 bangles and other utensils furnitures etc. to the accused persons as per their demand.
4. That after 1/4 months of marriage all the accused persons started to torture upon the complainant both physically and mentally and they demanded further cash of Rs. 50,000/- as a further demand from her father which the father of complainant could not fulfil.

5. That the facts of ill treatment, torture and assault upon the complainant gradually increasing. The accused persons started to assault the complt. by lathi, mercilessly and the supply of food upon the complt. was very irregular and even small quantity and they started to assault and fix torture upon the petitioner by various ways both physically and mentally.
6. That even after bearing impersistent torture, the complainant did not leave her matrimonial home with the hope that good day would come and in such circumstances on 18th day of Ashrayan 1423 B.C. the accused no. 1 mixed the poison with the food of the complainant for the purpose of murder her.
7. That lastly on 25th day of Falgun 1423 B.C. all the accused persons started to assault the complainant by lathi and also by fist and blows mercilessly and there after they drove her out from the house and according the complainant compelled to go her father house and she reported the matter to her parents and others.
8. That the complainant reported the matter to the C/C Baghundi p.s. but police did not take any steps against the accused persons. The accused no. 1 is trying to contract the second marriage very soon.

9. That the complainant also reported the matter to the S.P. Purulia on 11.4.2017 but there is no fruitful result till today, so the complainant has been compelled to take shelter before the Ld. Court.

10. That the complainant is a helpless woman and she is not in a position to prosecute the case in her personal capacity and for such reason a police case is desirable.

It is, therefore prayed that your honour may be graciously pleased to sent this petition of ~~exemption~~ complaint to the O/C Bagmundi p.s. to treating the same as P.I.R and to investigate the same as provided u/s 156(3) Cr.P.C.
