The above named complainant

segs to state as follows :-

1. That the complainant is very poor and below poverty line resident.
2. That the complainant after the cultivation and incidental work <sup>of</sup> family concern used to go to work within Burdwan district <sup>of</sup> earning, he along with his wife and mother-in-law had been to work there as labour wherein the labours get their fooding such as rice, vegetable etc. and daily salary as labour is Rs. 150/200 per day.
3. That the complainant has got a daughter who is aged about 15/16 years and a student of Manbesar High School of class -X and she has got a cycle as per the rule of Government in the last year.
4. That the complainant and his wife after working at Burdwan after working there three months returned to village wherein his other brother's and others reside and his daughter ~~is~~ was kept under his care.
5. That the complainant brought about Rs. 25,000/-/Rs. 30,000/- money after working as a labour along with his wife and mother-in-law and he sold his pair of bullock to one Kartik Sauri at Rs. 25,000/- about two days ago from the date of occurrence and he with a view to keep the money

for the marriage of daughter was going to Mandya Bank.

6. That on the date of occurrence the complainant with a view to keep the money in the <sup>Joint Bank</sup> ~~Joint Bank~~ branch in his savings bank Account of Rs. 50,000/- at Mandya in a cloth bag in which the Pass book also was taken by the complainant and was proceeding towards Mandya in a cycle which was given to his daughter from her school at that time at about 10 A.M. while he reached near the ~~Mandya~~ <sup>Mandya</sup> village here at that time all the accused persons encircled and gheroud ~~from~~ him and forced him to get down from the cycle and started slapping ~~him~~ and they snatched away the cycle of the complainant and the bag in which the Rs. 50,000/- money and the pass book of the bank was kept.

7. That ~~he~~ raised alarm to ~~the~~ <sup>the</sup> village more there were so many persons they reached the place of occurrence in the mean time the accused Ajay and Dilip Sauri took away the cycle and the bag and due to heavy altercation in between the two groups one Civil Police namely Aniya Sauri ~~called~~ <sup>called</sup> telephone to the O.C. Mandya and immediately within few minutes the O.C. and the S.D.O. Mandya came to the <sup>Place of</sup> occurrence and the assembled people along with complainant informed the entire facts to the O.C. and S.D.O. and both of them after ~~one~~ search brought out the cycle from the house of Dilip as well as Ajay who resides <sup>in</sup> ~~at~~ same compound but neither the bag nor money nor the Pass Book was recovered and immediately written information was given to the O.C. and S.D.O. of Mandya and both of them

assured to recover the money from the accused persons but they did not keep their words to recover the money or the Pass Book and when again and again the complainant met with then the O.C. Mandasar requested to get a information submit regarding the missing of the Pass book which was numbered as 754/2017 dated 15/01/2017.

8. That though the O.C. Mandasar P.S. assured to get the case started but till 09/04/2017 as no case was started by O.C. Mandasar and accordingly the complainant informed the S.P. Purulia 10/04/2017.

9. That even after information to the S.P. Purulia no case has yet been started, the complainant has been compelled to file this petition before this Id. Court u/s- 156(3) of Cr.P. Code as the complainant is a poor labour such petition is filed.

It is, therefore, prayed that your Honour may be graciously pleased to pass an order to send this petition to O.C. Mandasar P.S. with a direction to investigate the case treating this petition as F.I.R. and to submit the report before the Id. Court.
