4. That the complainant/petitioner came to know the fact of kidnaping after coming back to home. The date of abduction was 18-3-2017.

5. That it is submitted by the complainant that he settled the marriage of her daughter on 20-4-2017 at Village-Dairachelli within Pancha 2,7.

6. That the marriage of the daughter of complainant was settled to be solemnized with one Prabin's Rajhi of Village-Dairachelli who is also same caste, but the accused No.1 might have come to know the marriage of the complainant's daughter with said Prabin's Rajhi and become envious and alongwith the other two accused conspired together and despatched her to some other unknown place.

7. That the petitioner/complainant collected some information that his daughter might have taken either in the
