SUB:-ATTEMPTED TO BURGLARY OF SOLAR TUBULAR BATTERIES FROM CELL PHONE TOWER DIMU IN-1121420 SITUATED AT VILLAGE DIMU, PO-RIGID UNDER KOTSHILA POLICE STATION

Sir,

Our organization Environ Solar Private Limited (Bhaskar Solar) is one of the leading company for maintenance and operation of mobile towers in the state, has been entrusted as Vendors of Indus Tower Limited the owners of towers.

By virtue of such appointment as vendor we have entrusted to look after and supervise different jobs such as operation and maintenance, fuel management and security surveillance. It is pertinent to mentioned that since mobile telecommunication is an essential service under the Telegraph Act and controlled by union government of India. We are duty bound to ensure uninterrupted service for 24x7x365 days each of the mobile tower.

Under the terms and condition such appointment as vendor the responsibility of tower and its ancillary materials have been vested upon us and we are duty bound to protect and safeguard all materials in any manner whatsoever lying and the requiring in order regularly uninterrupted operation of the tower.

We would like to inform you that during the intervening night of 10-11 July, 2017 at any point of time unknown miscreants made an attempted for burglary of batteries from cell phone tower DIMU the said batteries were kept inside the electrical meter room.

That Sir, unknown criminal who was came with intention of burglary was not well versed with job when he was trying to detach batteries from main structure of the cabinet caused severe damaged to 16 NOS Solar Tubular 300 AH Exide batteries. The said batteries serve as backup for the tower during power outage. The worth of the materials is approximately Rs.280000/- in the open market. The incident came to light in the morning (11 July, 2017) when Technician Mr. Bishal Karmarkar (Mob-8336921652) & Cluster Manger Mr. Prosenjit Adhikary (Mob-8336917716) are went on tour for routine inspection of site.

Since we are the custodian of all the apparatus and materials of the tower and as such loss of these infrastructures would come as a handicap for the company also affecting safety and operational cost. Further from the point of operational view this technical value of the target created serious bottlenecks and setback to communication effort.

You would appreciate that such incident in a public utility service may result in complete breakdown of the mobile system. We would request your kind intervention in the matter would help to stop such maliciously destruction of establishment property by unknown criminal / miscreants in order to malign the name of our company in the market.

On behalf of the company I would like to request you to conduct an inquiry into the incident of burglary.

Please treat this note as an official complaint, and record it in the F.I.R.
