Most respectfully begs to state:

1. That the complainant has been appointed as president of Arsha High School (HS) by the District (Director of Secondary Education) on 12/09/2015.
2. That prior to appointment of your complaint as President the accused viz. Amarnath Biswas, Headmaster of Arsha High School (HS) was in charge of all the activities of school.
3. That after appointment as President the complainant asked the headmaster viz. Amarnath Biswas to hand over charge to your petitioner. The headmaster viz. Amarnath Biswas and other authority of Arsha High School (HS) handed over in complete charge by preparing false documents. Your petitioner came to learn that there is mis-appropriation of huge amount i.e. crores and crore of rupees in various ways by the headmaster Amarnath Biswas and others. So he is not handing over the complete charge.
4. That your petitioner asked to headmaster Sri Amarnath Biswas to explain the anomaly and discrepancies in account, but said headmaster Sri Amarnath Biswas did not explain the same nor gave any account of withdrawal of money which is to the tune of Rs. Crore.
5. That it is needless to mention here that Amarnath Biswas was the sole authority of call for meeting, fixed issues in meeting use to write resolution etc.
6. That the complainant asked to call executive meeting and general meeting but attempts were in vain.
7. That your petitioner started personal enquiry (and came to learn that said Amarnath Biswas the headmaster in connivance with other has / have withdrawn the grant

money which was sanctioned/allowed for the student of schedule cast and schedule tribe (Backward Class Welfare Fund) to the tune of lakhs and lakhs and misappropriated, caused wrongful gain to himself and others and wrong full loss to others.

8. That aid for the hostel students is sanctioned / allowed/ granted, who took their admission in the hostel, from government. But said Amarnath Biswas raised bills against some unknown student ^{whose name is} shows, no such student then as admitted students but never admitted nor their existence of such students nor they were member of hostel, but the accused, Amarnath Biswas the headmaster in collusion and conspired with others withdraw the money and misappropriated the fund which is in the tune of lakhs and lakhs. The accused Amarnath Biswas also manufactured, fabricated false papers.
9. That the said headmaster Amarnath Biswas raises requisition for hostel grant of the students who were not admitted till April or May of the year, through the bills were raised on and from January and the bills were granted, amounts were withdrawn and misappropriated. The amount is to the tune of lakhs and lakhs.
10. That as per SHG Group Scheme Dresses are allotted in favour of student and the dress is required to be distributed amongst the students but the said headmaster Amarnath Biswas withdrawn a sum of Rs. 2,40,000/- on 01/09/2015 and a sum of Rs. 2,48,000/- on 03/09/2015 on account of dress and misappropriated the fund said Amarnath Biswas, the accused ^{for} ~~for~~ ^{forgoing} manufactured papers for the same. Withdrawal the cash and diversion of fund by not distributing dress amongst the student specially in Backward Class and misappropriated the fund.
11. That the said headmaster viz. Amarnath Biswas with his conspirator also misappropriate the fund of mid day meal.

12. That the complainant being the President of school lodged complaint to the District Magistrate, Purulia on 04/05/2017 but of no good. The Xerox copy of the complaint is enclosed herewith.
13. That the matter was also reported to Officer-in-Charge, Arsha P.S. and other authorities but no action has yet been started.
14. That thereafter the matter was duly reported to Superintendent of Police, Purulia on 20/07/2017 but no action has yet been taken rather your petitioner was directed to come through this Ld. Court.
15. The Xerox copy of the complaint to District Magistrate, Purulia, Superintendent of Police, Purulia, Officer-in-Charge, Arsha P.S. and others are enclosed herewith.
16. That as the matter required through enquiry seizure of various documents, also ^{with the help of} statement of bank, cheques hence the case is required to be investigated by police officer hence this petition u/s 156(3) Cr. P.C.

It is therefore prayed that your Honour will be graciously pleased to send this petition to Officer-in-Charge, Arsha P.S., as contemplated u/s 156(3) Cr. P.C. treating the same as an FIR and to start a case and to investigate in to the case, unearth the wrongdoer and to proceed in accordance with law against the accused and others.
