In the matter of an application u/s 156 (3) Cr.P.C.

The Complainant named above begs to state as follows:-

- 1) That the Complainant is the wife of the Injured of the incident Sri Sudhir Mandal i.e. the Witnesses no-2 .
- 2) That said Sri Sudhir Mandal and his brother Gunadhar Mandal i.e. the Witness no-4, are the joint owners of the Tank named as 'Geram-Garia' which is situated within Mouza-Parashiya, under Hura P.S. in which they used to grow fishes there jointly.
- 3) That the Complainant came to learn that since sometime passed, fishes were being stolen from the Tank by some miscreants and as such on the date of incident i.e on 06/04/2017 at about 4 a.m. Sri Sudhir Mandal, the husband of the Complainant had a surprised visit to their Tank when he found that the Accused no-1 Sri Chandi Charan Mandal was catching fishes with the help of a 'Thela-Jaal'(Small Hand-Net) who then scolded said Chandi Charan Mandal and ordered him to leave the Tank with his Net.
- 4) That over that matter, there was a hot altercation between the Husband of the Complainant and the Accused no- 1 while the Accused no-1 threatened the husband of the Complainant that he will be soon treated a good lesson and left the Tank hurriedly.
- 5) That the said Sudhir Mandal, husband of the Complainant then wandered through the embankments of the Tank and thereafter while after watching the Tank, he was returning to his house, then at about 5 a.m. all the five Accused Persons being armed with Lathi, Iron Rods, Stones and Brickbats wrongfully restrained him near his house and all on a sudden started assaulting him mercilessly.
- 6) That hearing the shrieks and shouts of the injured Sudhir Mandal, the Complainant and the other witness no-3 to 8 came out from their residence and witnessed the occurrence and found that Sudhir Mandal being seriously injured fell on the ground and was groaning with pain. The Complainant and her family members i.e. the witness no- 3 and 4 with folded hands requested

the Accused Persons not to assault Sudhir any further but the Accused Persons paid no heed to their appeal and started hurling threats to them of dire consequences.

- 7) That seeing the other witnesses and many other maholla people to come rushing to the P.O, the Accused Persons left the place with their weapons.
- 8) That the Complainant and the aforesaid witnesses then anyhow managed to take the injured inside the house and found that the victim Sudhir Mandal suffered fracture injuries on his right hand and also sustained grievous injuries on his legs, waist, chest and on different parts of his person. At that time the victim Sudhir Mandal disclosed to them about the incident of the Tank also.
- 9) That thereafter the Witness no-3 Joydev Mandal, Witness no-8 Asit Mandal and Witness no-5 Sridam Mandal took the Injured Sudhir Mandal to Hura P.S. by a 'Sumo Gold' Vehicle and narrated the entire incident to the concerned Police Officer who seeing the Injuries and the precarious condition of the Injured, asked the attending group to take immediately the injured to any hospital first and accordingly the injured was taken by them directly to Bankura Sanmilani Medical College and Hospital where he had to undergo major Operation of his right hand and a Steel Plate was inserted there which is still in existence. There the Injured had to pass through a prolong treatment and at the time of discharge there from, he was advised by the Doctor to visit the Hospital for further follow-up and accordingly he used to visit the said Hospital.
- 10) That the Complainant Group having noticed that the Police of concerned P.S. even inspite of the Information lodged to them by the Complainant Group on the date of incident had taken no step against the Accused Persons, decided to inform the matter to S.P. Purulia.
- 11) That having come to know about such intention and or preparations of the Complainant Group for taking action against the Accused Persons, the Accused Persons lodged a false Complaint against the Injured Sudhir Mandal on the basis of which he has been arrested and is still under custody.

- 12) That the Complainant on 11/07/2017 informed the matter to the Superintendent of Police, Purulia for proper action against the accused Persons but even then as no step has been taken against the Accused Persons by the police, the Complainant has been compelled to lodge this Petition u/s 156(3) Cr.P.C. before Your Honour's Court.
- 13) That the Accused Persons have thus committed offences punishable u/s 147/148/149/323/341/325/326/506 and u/s 379/511 IPC.
- 14) That the Complainant being a helpless and poor lady is unable to arrange for producing the Witnesses in Court. Moreover the Injury Reports of the Injured (B.H.T) as well as other Medical Papers and X-Ray Plates are to be collected from the concerned Hospital and the incriminating weapons are to be recovered from the Accused Persons which could not be possible without police help.

In the circumstances stated above, it is prayed that Your Honour may be graciously pleased to send this Complaint to the O.C. Hura P.S. with a direction to treat the same as FIR and to start investigation in the matter and to prosecute the Accused Persons as per Law.
