but the complainant said the accused persons that at time of marriage complainant's father has given all dowry demand so, at that moment he was unable to fulfill extra dowry.

6. That most of the day of that time, the accused persons used to beat the complainant by Lathi for get her out from the matrimonial house but the complainant did not get out from matrimonial house <sup>on day</sup> So, at night her mother in law served ~~Petitioner~~ food to the complainant but some how the complainant came to know the actual truth so, she did not eat the food and next day in the morning she left her matrimonial house and take shelter at her father's house.

7. That the complainant informed this matter to her parents and as per instruction of her parents the complainant lodged a complain before Purulia (M) P.S. <sup>for</sup> getting proper relief.

8. That But there, Purulia (M) P.S. compromised the matter, So, the complainant again go her matrimonial house.

9). That again, matrimonial house members forced the complainant for <sup>buying</sup> extra dowry of Rs. 50,000/- for purchasing a new Byke for the husband of the complainant and in reply the complainant ~~told~~ that her father was unable to fulfill their demand as because at the time of marriage her father has spent a huge some money which was beyond his capacity for this reason her father was unable.

10). That on 02.07.2017 the complainant's husband Shovan Rajwar, father in law Nimai Rajwar, mother in law Rani Rajwar brother in law Sasanta Rajwar, and his wife Sabitri Rajwar beat the complainant with Lathi and Iron Rod, As a result of

which, bleeding came out from the Mouth of the complainant so, the complainant informed this matter to her parents, by Mobile phone and her parents came to her matrimonial house without any delay. There matrimonial house members abused them in filthy language.

11) That later complainants parents brought her to Purulia (M) P.S. for lodging a complain against her matrimonial house members, Their with the help of Police personal of Purulia (M) P.S. compromised the matter and prepared a declaration where her husband noted down that in future he will not torture the complainant". 12)x

12). That later the complainant, her husband and matrimonial members <sup>with her</sup> house, crossing the entrance of the P.S., her husband and her matrimonial house members beat her so, the complainant felt uneasy there and called her parents, so, her parents informed this incident to the P.S. personal and brought her to Deben Mahato Sadar Hospital Purulia.

13). That there the attending doctor admitted her in Sedar Hospital as because her condition is critical. The complainant was admitted in Deben Mahato Sadar Hospital since 02.07.17 to 04.07.2017.

14). That the complainant has two child, one daughter 5 years old and one son 3 years old. The complainant husband has printed card for his second marriage.

15). That after discharging from the hospital the complainant first went to her matrimonial house for bringig her daughter and son to her father's house. but from the entrance of her matrimonial house she was driven out by her husband and matrimonial house members.
