Sir,

In producing herewith one dumper (06 wheeler) bearing No. WB 37B/6585 loaded with stolen dust coal approx 10 MTs with proper seizure list. Fact of the case in brief is that on 11/12.08.17 night myself along with C/515 Gobardhan Mahato and C/1434 Jagannath Mondal were on night mobile duty on Raghunathpur – Chelliyama road and received a source information that the dumper having Reg. No. WB 37B/6585, being loaded with stolen coal, is coming from Kargali side towards Raghunathpur. After receiving this information, I informed the matter to O/C Raghunathpur PS and as per direction of O/C Raghunathpur we had been to Raghunathpur – Chelliyama road near at Moutorh more placed Naka Checking with a view to intercept the said vehicle. At 01:05 hrs we found that one dumper is coming from Kargali side. Seeing police party the driver of the said dumper attempt to flee away with the dumper but on being chased the driver stopped the dumper on road and the driver and Khalasi fled away in the dark side beside the road. I searched the dumper and found that about 10 MTs dust coal loaded in this dumper and the key of the dumper has been left away in the dumper by the driver. We searched the surrounding area with torch light to find out the driver but failed to trace out him. It is reasonable to believe that driver and owner of the said dumper collected the said dust coal either theft or by any illegally means and transporting to run a clandestine business habitually for wrongful gain. In order to ascertain the veracity of the fact I held local enquiry at Kargali and during enquiry it is revealed that two persons namely (1) Tapas Chatterjee of Vill.- Koldih, PS – Para and (2) Shyamal of Barrah village have illegally procured that dust coal and was transporting to run a clandestine business habitually for wrongful gain. So, the driver, owner of the said dumper and 02 (two) above noted persons are liable for punishable offence U/S 379/411/413/414 IPC. Hence, I seized the said dumper loaded with approx 10 MTs dust coal under proper seizure list.

I therefore pray that kindly lodge a FIR against the driver, owner of the dumper bearing No. WB 37B/6585 and 02 (two) above noted persons as per law and arrange its investigation.
