SUB: - COMPLAIN AGAINST CULPRIT PERSONS FOR CRIMINAL BREACH OF TRUST, CONSPIRACY, UNLAWFUL SWITCHING OFF MOBILE TOWER, CRIMINAL INTIMIDATION, BLACKMAILING, FORCIBLY OBSTRUCTION IN THE FREE EGRESS AND INGRESS, CONTINUOUS DISRUPTION IN THE PROPER RADIO NETWORK FLOW (MOBILE) AND UNLAWFULLY ASSEMBLY FOR STOP OF OPERATION OF MOBILE TOWER CAUSING IMMENSE PUBLIC LOSS AT TELECOM TOWER SITE DIMU IN-1121420 SITUATED AT VILLAGE-DIMU, PO-RIGID UNDER THE LIMIT OF KOTSHILA POLICE STATION .

Sir,

Our organization Bhaskar Solar is one of the leading company for maintenance and operation of mobile towers in the state, has been entrusted as Vendors of Indus Tower Limited the owners of towers.

By virtue of such appointment as vendor we have entrusted to look after and supervise different jobs such as operation and maintenance, fuel management and security surveillance. It is pertinent to mentioned that since mobile telecommunication is an essential service under the Telegraph Act and controlled by union government of India. We are duty bound to ensure uninterrupted service for 24x7x365 days each of the mobile tower.



We would like to inform you that on 31 August, 2017 at about 0940 hrs when our site technician Bishal Karmakar visited the said site to maintain continuity of fuel supplies for running of site. The culprit person mentioned above illegally trespassed into the above telecom tower site along with their men and agents and forcefully snatched the site keys and 50 litres of diesel fuel along with Rs.2000/- from our technician and said culprit person also shutdown the operation of telecom tower forcefully thereby hindering the operation as well as ingress and egress to the said mobile tower as a result there is complete breakdown of mobile telecom services as provided by the complainant company. Further he ousted our worker from business place of the company, threatened our said technician with dire consequences and also put the site under his own lock and key and then culprit person above named fled away and threatened to our site technician and others employees that he will kill them all by professional killer if they informed about the matter anywhere. Due to this maliciously purposeful act of the culprit person causing wide spread disruption to the mobile telephone service in the nearby area of the site which directly damaged to company image and reputation.

The said culprit person has been causing the above disturbance to us for the fulfilment of his demand to get huge sum of money (Rs.160000/-) from company by threatening and blackmailing into the agreeing to the demand otherwise he will disrupt the operational activities of the DIMU Telecom site. Such disruption activity on the part of the said person has brought immense loss to the public at large and for which he is solely liable. Due to this act and action of the aforementioned person company has incurred financial loss of Rs.100000/- per day in the shape of penalty imposed by Indus Tower Limited.

Such incident, as reported above, has caused serious disruption of mobile services, which is an essential, emergency and round the clock service of the District. Therefore, it is our humble request before your good office that mobile service is essential public utility service and such disruptions are only aimed in fostering wide spread panic and anarchy in our social life wherein the support of administration is extremely essential to immediately curb such destructive endeavour it is not only cause business loss but also leads large scale disruption in public life such activities squarely fall within the ambit of offence under section 25/25A of Indian Telegraph Act, 1885.


