Sir,

In producing herewith namely Balaram Gorai (52 yrs) S/o-Lt. Jyotilal Gorai of Baghmundi, P.S.- Baghmundi, Dist.-Purulia and accused namely Joypal Mura (32 yrs) S/O-Gamu Mura of Baghmundi, P.S.- Baghmundi, Dist.-Purulia along with 58 (fifty eight) Bags rice as per seizure list. I S.I. Sajal Kr. Mishra of DEB Purulia lodged a complaint against the above noted accused person on 15.10.17 at 14:05 hrs received a credible source information that one Bolero Pick-up Bearing Registration No. WB56A/6011 loaded with Plastic Bags which were filled with rice of PDS. This refers to Balarampur P.S. GDE No. 648 dt. 15.10.17. I requested District Controller food and supply Purulia over telephone to depute a Competent Officer from his end to remain present during holding raid, search, seizure and arrest but he expressed his inability to provide any such assistance for want of manpower at his end at present. I also contacted with BDO Balarampur and Inspector Food and supply Balarampur but they were unable to attend the raid programme as they were out of station. Since any delay in working out the said information I myself along with HG/1524 Birendra Nath Hansda of DEB Purulia, ASI. 121 Balaram Mahato, C/1157 Khaja Sams Basar, C/98 Anil Orang of Balarampur P.S. left for Rasuldih village on Balarampur-Baghmundi road to work out that information. After waiting there we found that one Bolero Pick-up van coming from Baghmundi side. We intercepted the said vehicle near Rasuldih village on 15.10.17 at 15:45 hrs. On checking it was found that the Registration No. of Bolero pick-up was matched giving by my source and found that 58 (fifty eight) bags rice loaded in plastic bags. Then we requested to the driver and his associate of the vehicle for producing relevant document, Challan, cash memo in respect of loaded rice in said Bolero pick-up van. But they failed to produce any relevant document or any satisfactory answer from where they procured the said rice, but they disclosed named and address as noted above. I interrogated the above noted persons and during interrogation he clearly stated that they procured PDS articles i.e. rice by illegal means from different places and stoked it and this rice which was loaded in this plastic bags other than PDS Bags for selling at Balarampur Market for causing their wrongful gain. So I seized the above noted Bolero Pick-up van loaded with PDS rice after preparing proper seizure list duly signed by the accused persons and accompanied Police persons as there was no availability of the local people as such I could not collect the signature of the local people in the seizure list. I arrested the above noted persons after observing all formalities regarding arrest. It is reasonable to believe that the driver and his associate made conspiracy to sell the PDS goods in open market at high price depriving the poor and needy card holder of BPL and AAY. The accused persons made criminal conspiracy to make such type of unlawful activities and thereby tried to create artificial crisis among the poor people of the society after forming an illegal business racket.

Hence driver of the vehicle Bearing Registration No. WB56A/6011 and his associate committed an offence punishable U/S-7(i)(a)(ii) of E.C. Act 1955 read with Sec-120B IPC for Violating the Provision as mentioned in Govt. Notification No. 2347-FS/Sectt/Food/4P-09/2012 dtd. 08.08.2013 under the West Bengal Public distribution system (maintenance and control) order 2013.

Hence I requested you start a Case U/S-7(i)(a)(ii) of E.C. Act 1955 read with Sec-120B IPC for Violating the Provision as mentioned in Govt. Notification No. 2347-FS/Sectt/Food/4P-09/2012 dtd. 08.08.2013 under the West Bengal Public distribution system (maintenance and control) order 2013 against the accused i) Balaram Gorai (52 yrs) S/o-Lt. Jyotilal Gorai of Baghmundi, P.S.- Baghmundi, Dist.-Purulia, ii) Joypal Mura (32 yrs) S/O-Gamu Mura of Baghmundi, P.S.- Baghmundi, Dist.-Purulia. A copy of the complaint, Xerox copy of seizure list is sent to District Controller Food and supply.
