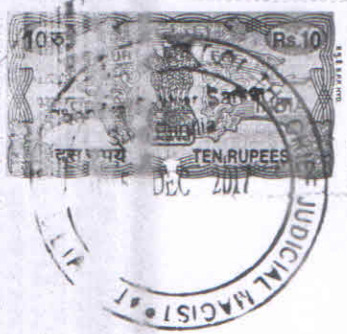

The above name complainant begs to state as follows:

1. That the complainant and the accused persons are permanent resident of village – Rangametya, under PS. Boro, Dist Purulia and within the jurisdiction of the Ld. Court
2. That on the date of occurrence the complainant was tending his cows in the grazing field and accused no. 1 Muktipada was also tending his cattles therein. At that time one ox belongs to the complainant dashed another ox which belongs to said Muktipada and that there was free fighting in between the said two animals. However both complainant and Muktipada somehow managed to disperse those animals but the said Muktipada became very much annoyed and aggressive and used filthy languages to the complainant. In spite of that the complainant did not make any protest to the unusual behavior of the said Muktipada that at about 12 noon while the complainant was returning back with his cattles and when he approached the village at that vary time the said Muktipada along with his brother Swapan Mahato and father Nakul Mahato arm with Lathi, Iron rod etc. restrained the complainant assaulted him by Lathi etc. by felling him on the ground and at the time of incident the accused persons snatched one titan wrist watch belongs to the complainant worth Rs. 1,150/- and one umbrella worth Rs. 250/-.

3. When the complainant protested then the accused person again abused him in filthy languages and also threatened him with dire consequences.
4. That at the time of incident the complainant raised hue and cry to save his life when the neighboring people as well as the witnesses collected there then the miscreants fled away.
5. That it is very pertinent to point out that prior to the date of incident some unknown cattle damaged the paddy of said Nakul Mahato for which they suspected that those cattles belongs to the complainant and that the accused persons demanded compensation to be paid by the complainant.
6. When the complainant asked them to identify those cattle which alleged to have damaged their paddy and then ask for compensation. Over the aforesaid issue there was some shorts of quarrel in between the parties. When the accused person threaten the complainant that they would take revenge of the same but the accused persons since the said incident bore graze against the complainant .
7. That the aforesaid incident was duly informed to the local police station as well as superintendent of police Purulia but none of them, though assured, have taken any legal action against the accused persons. For which the complainant is compelled to file the complaint before the Id. Court under the law that the accused person have committed various offenses under the penal law

In the circumstances it is prayed that Your Honour may be pleased to send this petition of compliant to the Officer-in-charge, Boro PS. treating the same as F.I.R. U/S 156(3) Cr. Pc. and for which act of kindness the complainant is on duty bound shall ever pray.
