Sub: Application for lodge a FIR regarding a street accident.

Respected Sir,

I, Munna Singh, aged about- 21 years, son of Ramji Singh, resident Vill+P.O: Kajora Gram, near Rail Colony, P.S: Andal, Dist: Burdwan West (W.B), most respectfully beg to state that on 04.12.2017 at about 03:30 P.M while I and my brother namely GUDDU KUMAR SINGH (since deceased), aged about- 20 years with some other friends, were proceedings towards Purulia from Asansol through the Barakar-Purulia Pitch Road by a Maruti Van, bearing Regd. no: WB-40AC/8186, when we reached in between Mahula more to Anara at that time all on a sudden one Mahindra Pick-Up Van being Regd. no: WB-37D/0339 came from opposite direction and suddenly turned into its right side (which is wrong side) due to lossing its control and dashed on the right side body of front wheel of our Maruti Van and one Bi-Cyclist with high speed, rash and negligence manner. As a result 1. (Myself), 2. Guddu Kumar Singh (driver of Maruti Van), 3. Manish Prasad (20 Yrs) son of Pramod Prasad Thakur, 4. Boby Mondal (26 Yrs) son of Late Mahendra Mondal, 5. Rajesh Turi (26 Yrs) son of Sunil Turi, 6. Anwar Sekh (29 Yrs) son of Late Kashem Sekh, all are resident of Vill+P.O: Kajora, P.S: Andal, Dist: Burdwan West, 7. Mukesh Paswan (28 Yrs) son of Late Baleswar Dushad of Bogra Chati, P.S: Jamuria, Dist: Burdwan West, 8. Rajib Singh son of Dinesh Singh of Sahebgunj, Jharkhand and 9. the Bi-Cyclist, were sustained severe bleeding injuries and both the vehicles and Bi-Cycle got badly damaged. With the help of local people all us shifted to the S.D Hospital, Raghunathpur for treatment later my brother (driver of the Maruti Van) referred to the BSMCH, Bankura for better treatment where he declared as brought death.

P.M was held over the dead body of deceased at the said Hospital vide Bankura P.S u/d Case No: 704/2017 dated 05.12.2017.

After sustaining injury in the said accident I along with others received mental pain and all of us busy for our treatment and last of all I was busy for ritual activities of my deceased brother for such, delay to submit the written complaint.

So, Sir, I request you to please do the needful regarding this matter as per law.
