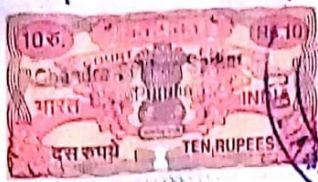

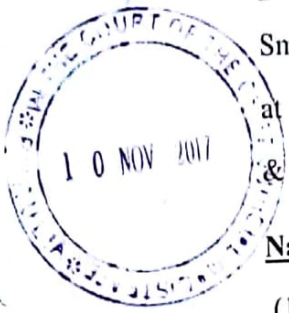

The above name complainant begs to state as follows:

- 1) That the complainant is the legally married wife of accused no-1 and their marriage was solemnized on 06/12/2013 at village- Pandui under P.S. Puncha and within the jurisdiction of this Ld. Court. The said marriage was solemnized as per Hindu Rites and customs following social rituals.
- 2) That at the time on in other words as per condition of the marriage as demanded by the accused persons of whom accused no-1 is husband, accused no-2 & 3 are the paternal -in-laws and accused no-4 is the sister-in-law though married residing with the accused nos. 1 to 3 as per demand of the accused persons the father of the complainant had to pay a cash of Rs. 2,00,000/- (Rupees Two Lakhs) along with Gold ornaments weighing of 9 bhories to the accused persons, but they will not satisfied

- as it is alleged that the articles are not standard and branded and accordingly they denied to accept those articles.
- 3) That however, after marriage the complainant went to matrimonial house and started to reside as husband and wife with the accused no-1 along with other accused persons and that initially relations was somehow well and good.
  - 4) That it is very pertinent to point out that before marriage the accused persons represented that the husband of the complainant is a permanent employee in Bank of India but thereafter the complainant learnt that he is working in the Bank as Contractual Basis. However, the complainant managed to console her that accused no-1 would somehow able to run the family and accordingly marital tie became the parties were then continued except some negligence dispute.
  - 5) That meanwhile the complainant gave birth a female child namely Sweety Roy now aged about 3 years and thereafter all the accused persons started torture upon the complainant without any laps and reasons and persistent torture was continued upon the complainant till she was driven out from her matrimonial house even the

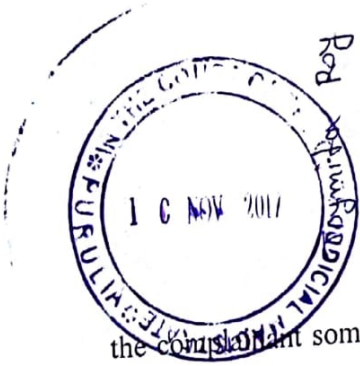

complainant has not provided minimum fooding, clothing, and daily necessities by the accused persons which caused great mental stoke even the accused persons used to assault the complainant in various ways . In-spite of that the complainant somehow managed to continue her matrimonial relationship and have for good days.

- 6) That while such state of thing was going on the accused persons after pre planed asked the complainant to bring a cash of Rs. 70,000/- for her for further dowry and when she refused then all the accused persons increase the degree of torture upon the complainant they even did not supply baby food to the newly born daughter which caused great mental agony in the mind of the4 complainant. In-spite of that the complainant never willing to break her matrimonial journey with the accused persons and they also gave out that unless the complainant fulfill their illegal demand they will not allow the complainant to stay at her matrimonial house and to continue the relationship with them.
- 7) That thereafter, on 08/07/2017 all the accused persons assaulted the complainant driven her out from her matrimonial house after snatching all her personal belonging / stridhan including gold ornaments etc., and



the complainant somehow left her matrimonial house and is residing at her paternal house.

- 8) That on 23/10/2017 at about 11:00 AM all the accused persons along with other 5 unknown persons came to the paternal house at village- Pandui under P.S. Pancha and threatened the complainant in filthy language and also gave out that they would murder the complainant , when the accused persons tried to snatch the said daughter from her lap at that time the4 complainant and her paternal relations tried to rescue her and that the altercation the accused persons assaulted the complainant with fist and blows causing major injuries on her body, and hearing such hue and cry the neighboring people collected there then the accused persons left the village.
- 9) That all the personal property and her stridhan of the complainant including gold ornaments is still under the custody of the accused persons which were actually entrusted to them by the complainant and now the complainant is in bare necessities of those articles but it is her belief that the accused persons have misappropriate of those articles.
- 10) That the complainant thereafter lodged one complaint to the local P.S. and when no legal action was taken by the

said Police then another complaint was lodged to the Superintendent of Police Purulia but same fate.

Hence the complainant is under compelling circumstance filed this complaint before this Ld. Court for appropriate legal action under the law.

In the circumstances it is therefore, prayed that your honour may be pleased to send the petition of complaint to the Officer-in-charge, Pancha, P.S. treating the same as FIR under section 156(3) for investigation .
