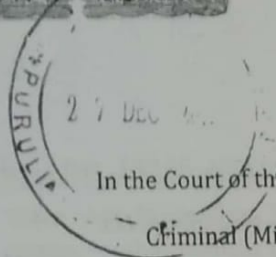

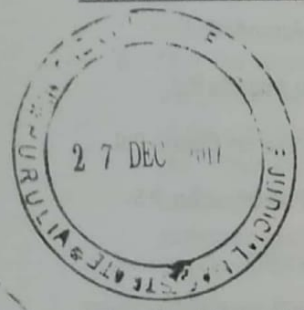

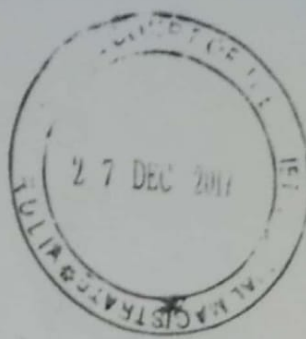


In the matter of an application u/s 156 (3) Cr.P.C.

The Complainant named above begs to state as follows:-

1. That the Complainant is the legally married wife of the Accused no-1. The witness no-2 is the father and witness no-3 is the uncle of the Complainant. Witness no-4 and 5 happen to be the Grandmother and youngest brother of the Complainant respectively and Witness no-5 is the next door neighbour of the Accused Persons.
2. That the Accused no- 2 and 3 are the Parents-in-law of the Complainant and Accused no-4 is the brother-in-law of the Complainant. Accused no-5 is the uncle of the Accused no-1.
3. That the Accused no-1 was married to the Complainant as per the Hindu rites and customs prevailing in their society, on 28/04/2017 corresponding to 14th day of Baisakh, 1424 B.S. at Chirka Shiv Mandir, P.S-Purulia(M), Dist-Purulia in presence of both the parties.

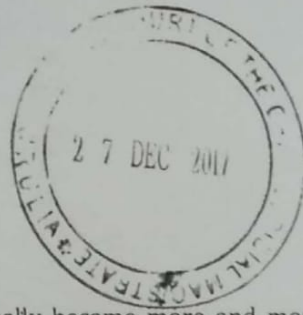

4. That at the marriage, the father of the Complainant gave Rs. 1,91,000/- (Rs. One Lakhs and Ninty One Thousands) in cash, 3 Varies of Gold ornaments, furniture, other utensils to the Accused Persons in presence of all his inmates as dowry as per their demand.
5. That after the marriage, the Complainant was taken by the Accused no-1 to his house and they started living there as husband and wife and the marriage tie is still exist.
6. That the Accused Persons were not satisfied with the cash and kinds which were given by the father of the Complainant to the Accused Persons at the time of the marriage. Soon after the marriage, they started demanding Rs. 35,000/- (Rs. Fifty Thousands) more as Additional Dowry from the father of the Complainant through the Complainant and also started creating persistent pressure upon her for asking her Father to give the additional dowry without any delay whatsoever. But when the Complainant expressed the inability of her father to pay any further sum as demanded by her father-in-law and her husband, the Accused Persons started torturing the Complainant both physically and mentally.
7. That the Complainant used to inform the very matter to the members of her parental house at the time of Asta Mangala. She also often used to inform the matter to her parents, uncle and other relations over phone or her relations as mentioned above used to advise the Complainant to bear all these tortures and used to console her saying that good days will surely come in future.
8. That thereafter in the last part of the month of Jaistha, 1424 B.S the Complainant got pregnant out of the wedlock of the marriage. She thought that henceforth she will get proper treatment but her expectation turned futile. Hearing the news of her pregnancy, all the Accused Persons started taking more oblique attitude. The Accused no-1 did not take her as is usually done in case of a pregnant woman and without doing so the Accused Persons started to ill treat the Complainant. She was started to be burdened with more domestic works and was not being provided with adequate foods. The Accused Persons also started to create persistent pressure upon the Complainant for abortion and when the Complainant denied to do such an illegal act, the torture upon the Complainant was accelerated. She often used to be assaulted by the Accused Persons.
9. That the Accused Persons openly declared to the Complainant that they are not agreeable to bear the cost of her nourishment at the pregnancy stage until they get the additional dowry as demanded by them.

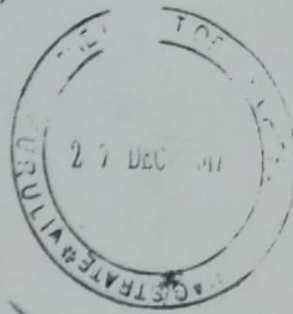

10. That the situation at the stage gradually became more and more unsecured and due to such inhuman mental and physical torture and negligence by the Accused Persons, within one month miscarriage was occurred.
11. That subsequently thereafter the demand for extra dowry was again raised with new force by the Accused Persons and they clearly stated to the Complainant that the very demand being not fulfilled by the father of the Complainant, the Complainant was started to be put into intolerable negligence and tortures which caused miscarriage to her.
12. That the Accused Persons even on some negligible domestic affairs used to harass the Complainant and the Accused no-1 under the influence of his parents and family members used to assault the Complainant and all the Accused Persons always used to provoke the Complainant to commit suicide. But the Complainant always used to bear all those tortures.
13. That thereafter in the month of Sraban, 1424 B.S once again the Complainant became pregnant and presently she is carrying 4-5 months of Pregnancy out of the wed-lock of their marriage.
14. That lastly on 08/12/2017 at about 9 p.m. the Accused no-1 entered into the house in drunken condition and started abusing the Complainant in filthy languages and was uttering obscene words in the name of her parents. The Complainant tried to protest against such act of the Accused no-1 to which all the accused persons grew annoyed and they started assaulting her mercilessly with kicks and blows and as a result of which the Complainant sustained severe pains on her body. The Accused no-1, being instigated by the other Accused Persons, informed the father of the Complainant over telephone to come and to take her daughter back to his house immediately. On that night they also drove the Complainant out from their house snatching all her gold ornaments. The Complainant on that night anyhow managed to take shelter outside of her in-laws house.
15. That subsequently on the very next day i.e. on 09/12/2017 the witness no 2, 3 and 5 had been to her in-laws house and they requested her in-laws to keep the Petitioner no-1 there. The Accused Persons at that time started abusing them in filthy languages and in a rowdy manner threatened them of dire consequences. They also threatened them that if the additional dowry be not paid to them, then their daughter will be killed. The family members of the Complainant also requested them and also expressed their inability to pay any further dowry as per their demand. The Accused Persons then became more violent and started assaulting them also with fist and blows.

16. That the Accused no-1 along with the other Accused Persons thereafter placed some blank white papers before the Complainant and his family members and asked them to put their signatures thereon. The Complainant, his father brother and uncle out of fear put their signatures on the very papers as demanded by the Accused Persons. The Complainant and her other family members apprehend that the Accused Persons may dishonestly use those blank papers signed by the Complainant and his family members for manufacturing any false documents and may use the same against them.
17. That being driven out by the Accused Persons, the Complainant and her father immediately on the very date i.e. on 09/12/2017 went to the local P.S. at Chas(Musil) but the concerned Police Officer did not accept the Complaint. In such circumstance the Complainant was compelled to return back with her father and her other family members on the very date to her father's place at Dimdiha, Purulia and since then she is spending her days there on the mercy of her poor father.
18. That after reaching her parental house, the Complainant on 10/12/2017 along with her father and other family members had been to Purulia(M) P.S at about 11:00 a.m for lodging the Complaint. The Complainant then informed the matter in details there to the police officer present in the P.S. who assured the Complainant and her companions that they will take appropriate steps and measures against the Accused Persons and on getting such assurance the Complainant, her father and others went back to their residence with the hope that police will take appropriate steps against the Accused Persons.
19. That when the Complainant found that the police practically has not taken any step whatsoever against the Accused Persons, the Complainant on 12/12/2017 submitted a Written Complaint before the Superintendent of Police, Purulia but even in spite of all these endeavors of the Complainant, no step has been taken by the police and as such the Complainant is being compelled to lodge this Petition u/s 156(3) Cr.P.C. before Your Honour's Court.
20. That presently the Accused Persons are holding out threats to the Complainant and her family members of dire consequences. The Complainant is a deserted pregnant woman and due to such inhuman torture both physically and mentally, she is now suffering from various ailments and presently is totally depending upon her poor father.
21. That the accused persons have thus committed the offences punishable u/s 498A/323/506/34 I.P.C. and u/s 3 and 4 Dowry Prohibition Act.

22. That all the gold ornaments are to be recovered from the Accused persons, the witnesses of the incident are to be collected and produced in Court which are beyond the capability of the Complainant who is a helpless and poor lady and for the very reasons, the matter should be investigated through police by treating this Written Complaint as F.I.R.

In the circumstances stated above, it is therefore Prayed that Your Honour may be graciously pleased to send this Complaint to the O.C. Purulia (M) P.S with a direction to treat the same as FIR and to start investigation in the matter and to Prosecute the accused persons as per law.
