The above name complainant begs to state as follows:

- 1) That the complainant is the legally married wife of the opposite party their marriage was solemnized on 5th day of Chaitra 1419 B.S. as per Hindu rites and customs and also solemnized all the formalities by exchange of garlands, putting on vermilion, Home etc, and their marriage is still subsisting.
- 2) That at the time of marriage as per demand of the husband of the complainant and other inmates, the mother of the complainant had to pay a cash of Rs. 60,000/- along with other gifts and articles but they were not happy.
- 3) That after marriage the complainant was brought to her matrimonial house by her husband and started to reside as husband and wife and in their wedlock one son namely Milan Paramanik was born.
- 4) That for about one year of their marriage the complainant was treated well at her matrimonial house but thereafter the husband of the complainant and the said Khageswar Paramanik started to demand a further cash of Rs. 40,000/- contrary to that they both put pressure upon the complainant and inflicted both mental and physical torture even not provided proper food and clothing even medicine at the time of her illness and the husband of the complainant who is a habitual drunker with the instigation

of said Khageswar assaulted the complainant mercilessly and driven the complainant out from their house for which she somehow manage to stay in the open verandah. However, bearing all sorts of torture the complainant somehow stayed at her matrimonial house but when the complainant was carrying for seven month both the aforesaid persons assaulted her and driven her out from her matrimonial house and since then she with her son both residing at her paternal house and the first rice of the minor son was taken place and though the husband f the complainant and other matrimonial inmates were informed to participate in the said occasion but none of them come at the paternal house of the complainant. Even for the 2 ½ years none of them had taken any information for both of them. Rather none of them provide any cash or clothing.

- 5) That on 25/12/2017 the husband of the complainant, Khageswar Paramanik and other six unknown persons all on a sudden without any information came to the paternal house of the complainant at village- Sarjumhatu, and pick up quarrel with the complainant and other family members and there was some sort of hot altercation the husband of the complainant hold the lock of hair of the complainant and pressed her neck and kicked her mercilessly for which the complainant sustained badly pain in her body then the neighboring people collected there and recue the
