Sir,

In producing here with the accused persons namely Kamal Mahato (45) S/O- Bistu Mahato of Bongara, PS- Joypur, Dist-Purulia and Kailash Mahato (25) S/O- Ledan Mahato of Tunta PS- Joypur Dist- Purulia brought under arrest along with seized articles as per seizure list i.e. one Hero Passion Pro Motor Cycle bearing registration No- JH 09AD 6796 and one tractor bearing registration no- WB41F 4676 fully loaded with fire woods apprx 10 quintal.

I, SI Shuvankar Sarkar of Joypur PS do hereby lodged a written complaint against the above noted accused persons to the effect that on 18/02/18 at 00.45 hrs, received a secret source information that one person was coming with one tractor fully loaded with woods at Baragram more. After receiving such information I informed this matter to IC Joypur PS and after discussion with IC Joypur PS, myself along with C/-859 Jitendranath Panday, C/-698 Sashadhar Mahato & C/- 245 Rabin Rajak were performing anti-crime night mobile duty near Katalard vide Joypur PS CC No-418/18 dated 17/02/18 rushed to the spot to work out the said information and on 18/02/18 at 00:55 hrs we reached near Baragram more and keeping our Govt. Vehicle No- WB 56 B 4920 in a safe distance we slowly moved to the information place and found one tractor was coming towards Borogram more and we intercepted the tractor and found that the tractor bearing registration no - WB 41F 4676 was fully loaded with fire woods and being asked the driver did not produced any documents regarding this fire woods. On interrogation he disclosed his identity as Kailash Mahato (25) S/O- Ledan Mahato of Tunta PS- Joypur Dist- Purulia. After some time one person also came to this place with a motor cycle bearing registration No- JH 09AD 6796 and claimed that he was the owner of this fire woods. I also asked to produce the documents regarding this fire woods. But he also failed to produce any document regarding this fire woods. On interrogation he disclosed his identity as Kamal Mahato (45) S/O- Bistu Mahato of Bongara, PS- Joypur, Dist-Purulia. So it is reasonably believe that the fire woods was stolen from any place.

I seized the said Hero Passion Pro Motor Cycle and tractor fully loaded with fire woods under a proper seizure list in presence of witnesses as well as accused person and make over one copy of the seizure list to them and they put their signature as token of acknowledgement and also labeled the same by me. I tried my label best to singed the public witnesses but as time is dead in night and in alone place and far distance from villages so none present there, So I unable to put signature any public witnesses on the seizure list. Hence they committed offence U/S 379/411/34 IPC read with sec 6,7(3) of West Bengal Forest Produce Transit Rules 1959, and Sec 52(i), 33 (i)(h) of the Indian Forest Act 1927.

I therefore pray that a specific case may kindly be started against the accused persons namely Kamal Mahato (45) S/O- Bistu Mahato of Bongara, PS- Joypur, Dist-Purulia and Kailash Mahato (25) S/O- Ledan Mahato of tunta PS- Joypur Dist- Purulia and owner of tractor under proper section of law and arrange its regular investigation.
