Sir,

In producing herewith 02 arrested accused persons namely (1) Rinku Shekh (28) S/o Lt. Makbul Shekh of Pandebswar, Phulbagan More Jamai Para, PS - Pandabeswar, Dist - Paschim Bardhaman and (2) Jasbant Singh (23) S/o Dhanu Singh of DVC Para, Pandabeswar, PS - Pandabeswar, Dist.- Paschim Bardhaman with following seized articles (1) One country made fire arms loaded with one round live cartridge, (2) One Bhojali, length 10" including 3.5" Butt and (3) One Maruti Omni vehicle bearing No. WB 40AJ/2037 I beg to report that today (26.02.18) at 20:05 hrs in course of my evening mobile duty (vide Raghunathpur PS GDE No 1301 dt 26.02.18) I received secret information from a source that a gang of criminals comprising of 06 heads under the leadership of above noted arrested persons, assembled beside near at Jharukhamar bridge (under Raghunathpur PS) being with fire arms and other deadly weapons etc with a view to commit dacoity in Kelahi Patrol Pump on Raghunathpur - Barakar Road.

Accordingly I informed the matter to O/C Raghunathpur PS, over phone and accordingly briefing to all my accompanying force as per direction of O/C Raghunathpur PS immediately I along with source and C/201 Rabindranath Nag, C/C/129 Haripada Rajwar vide Raghunathpur PS CC No 846/18 dt 26.02.18, left for the spot to work out the source information with Govt. vehicle No WB 56B/4921. At 20:45 hrs we reached at the place where the accused were assembled and preparing themselves for committing dacoity. From distances at about 50 yards we cordoned them. Their whispering came to our knowledge regarding committing of dacoity in the Kelahi Patrol Pump. We crawled nearer to them and disclose our identity and asked them to surrender; at that time, they all started to fled away, we chased them by using dragon light device. After a hot chase we could able to apprehend (1) Rinku Shekh (28) S/o Lt. Makbul Shekh of Pandebswar, Phulbagan More Jamai Para, PS - Pandabeswar, Dist - Paschim Bardhaman and (2) Jasbant Singh (23) S/o Dhanu Singh of DVC Para, Pandabeswar, PS - Pandabeswar, Dist.- Paschim Bardhaman and 04 (Four) others were fled away but on several interrogation the above noted arrested did not disclosed the identity of other 04 (four) accused persons. On further interrogation they stated that they along with 04 (four) others were assembled there and preparing themselves for committing dacoity at Kelahi Patrol Pump. We searched the above noted persons and following items were recovered from their possession, as (1) One country made fire arms loaded with one round live cartridge from the possession of accused Jasbant Singh, (2) One Maruti Omni vehicle having Reg. No. WB 56B/4921 which was standing beside the spot and One Bhojali, length 10" including 3.5" Butt from the possession of accused Rinku Shek, on interrogation accused Rinku Shek admitted before me that he is the driver of above noted Maruti Omni Van. On demand, they failed to give any satisfactory explanation in respect of their presence in this area in that time with such deadly weapons. So it is crystal clearly that they were assembled in that area to commit dacoity. As such the above noted accused persons were arrested maintaining all guidelines of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India and seized the above noted articles under proper seizure list duly signed by the accused persons and witnesses. At that time no public witnesses were present at the abandoned area.

On return to PS, I lodge a complaint against (1) Rinku Shekh (28) S/o Lt. Makbul Shekh of Pandebswar, Phulbagan more Jamai Para, PS - Pandabeswar, Dist - Paschim Bardhaman and (2) Jasbant Singh (23) S/o Dhanu Singh of DVC Para, Pandabeswar, PS - Pandabeswar, Dist.- Paschim Bardhaman & 04 (four) unknown accused persons for starting a case as per law and also for arranging its investigation.
