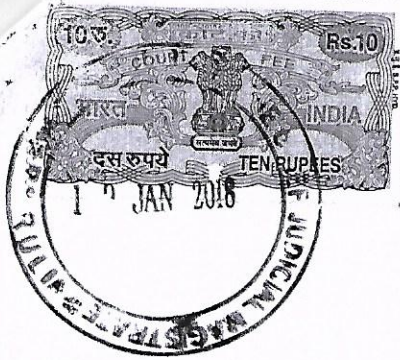

The humble petition on behalf of the
complainant /Petitioner;

Most respectfully sheweth :-

1. That, your petitioner happens to be the legally married wife of the accused No.1 and the marriage between them was settled through negotiation and solemnised at Village- Rohingara at the father's house of the petitioner on the 04th day of Baisakh, 1418 B.S. corresponding to 18/04/2011.

2. That, although the father of the petitioner happens to be a prolétarian, he by way of taking loan from his friends and relatives had procured money to meet the demand so made on the side of the accused at the time of settlement of the marriage between the petitioner and the accused No.1. Pursuant to the demand so made on the side of the accused the father of the petitioner had

gold ornaments weighing about 18 gms. viz. a necklace (12 gms.) and one pair of ear rings (6 gms.) to the petitioner besides furniture, utensils etc.

3. That, the petitioner, after her marriage had stepped into the threshold of her matrimonial house with a lot of hopes and dreams locked into her heart towards leading a happy conjugal life with the accused No.1 and amidst other in-laws, viz, the rest accused persons except Nos. 7 and 8.

4. That, during the introductory days of the petitioner's stay at her matrimonial house the accused No.1 used to show longings towards the petitioner and the rest of the accused except Nos. 7 and 8 used to shower love and affection towards her but the same was a transitory phenomenon and did last for only one month or so.

5. That, the petitioner thereafter had been saddled with the onerous liability of doing the house-chores alone and even on the slightest laches and lapses on her part in doing the same she was subjected to utter humiliation and physical torture by the in-laws viz. accused Nos. 4 to 6 who happen to be the sisters-in-law of the petitioner. She used to be taunted off and on as an "awkward looking ominous lady" by them. The petitioner in her bid to get rid of such humiliation and sarcastic comments of her sisters-in-law requested the accused No.1 to forbid the sisters-in-law but the latter instead of taking exception to such conduct of the sisters-in-law of the petitioner

a mismatch for him as well as for his family both in consideration of her countenance and financial status of her family.

6. That, the petitioner brooked all such torture in anticipation of prospective happiness but the accused persons except Nos. 7 and 8 did not mend themselves.

7. That, although the petitioner, since the very inception of her leading conjugal life with the accused No.1 experienced that the latter was addicted to wine and used to return home late at night she took it lying down.

8. That, the accused No.1 after one and a half year from the date of marriage started inflicting physical torture upon the petitioner being aided and instigated by the rest accused except Nos. 7 and 8. Such torture continued even when the petitioner got conceived in the year 2013 and gave birth to a male baby in the year 2014.

9. That, since after the birth of the male baby the petitioner was thinking of certain change in the behaviour of the accused except No. 7 and 8 but torture upon her remained unabated.

10. That, the accused No.1 started putting pressure upon the petitioner demanding an additional dowry to the tune of Rs. 80,000/- as according to him the cash that

of the petitioner's father was much below his expectation and for that he could not purchase a motor bike. Now he has decided to purchase the same and the petitioner has to procure the said sum of Rs. 80,000/- for the purpose from her father. The petitioner very politely requested the accused No.1 not to put such pressure upon her inasmuch as her father would never be able to fulfil such demand he being bereft of any other financial resources besides being a day labourer. On hearing such refusal the accused No.1 got flared up and escalated the torture upon the petitioner both physically and mentally.

11. That such an episode of torture upon the petitioner by the accused No.1 for non-procurement of the demanded sum of Rs. 80,000/- continued until the petitioner was driven out from her matrimonial house after merciless beating last on 19th day of Kartick this year (06/11/2017). The petitioner was not allowed to take her son at the time of such driving out by the accused except Nos. 7 and 8.

12. That, the petitioner, finding no alternative, took refuge at her father's house and narrated all such incidents to her parents and others.

13. That, the petitioner thereafter got altogether non-plussed when she to her utter surprise heard that the accused except Nos. 7 and 8 had already declared her dead and Shradha ceremony had been held on the 3rd day of Agrahayan (20/11/2017) and the son of the petitioner

petitioner after getting tonsured. Relatives of the accused except Nos. 7 and 8 were amongst the invitees of such ceremony besides the Village people of the petitioner's matrimonial home.

14. That, having been aware of such inhuman activities of the accused persons except Nos. 7 and 8 the petitioner being accompanied by her father and elder brother being witness Nos. 2 and 4 had been to her matrimonial house on the 13th day of Agrahayan (30/11/2017) and on reaching there became more dumb-founded when they found that a newly married wife was in the house of the accused. On being asked the said lady disclosed that she got married with the accused No.1 last on 27/11/2017. She told that she hails from village Chitarpur under Kotshila P.S. and her name is Sanaka Mahato cited as accused No.7 and she is the daughter of Sri Rabi Mahato, cited as accused No.8. The petitioner and her companions found the son of the petitioner in tonsured condition and her son also got astonished seeing his mother alive there.

15. That, the accused persons thereafter humiliated the petitioner and her father and brother so accompanying her and also gave out that since the accused No.1 has got remarried the petitioner could not be allowed to stay there and at the same time warned that if the petitioner even thereafter dares to stay there she would be charred to death.

16. That, finding no alternative the petitioner returned to her father's house therefrom with her father and brother.

17. That, thereafter on the selfsame date i.e. on 30/11/2017 the petitioner had been to Kotshila P.S. and lodged written complaint therewith against all the accused inter alia stating all such incidents in details but as till 20/12/2017 no specific case had been started against the accused your petitioner informed the matter in writing to the Superintendent of Police, Purulia on 20/12/2017 but till date no action has been taken.

18. That, the fact of the case highly warrants Police investigation and hence such petition before the Id. Court.

It is, therefore, prayed that your Honour may graciously be pleased to forward the instant petition of complaint to the Officer-in-Charge, Kotshila P.S. with a direction upon him to cause investigation into the case as contemplated U/S- 156(3) Cr.P.C. treating the same as an F.I.R.
