The above name complainant begs to state as follows:

- 1) That the complainant is the legally married wife of the accused no-1 and their marriage was solemnized on 5th Falgun 1411 B.S. a per Hindu Rites and Customs as prevalent in their community and also by observing the formalities like putting on vermilion, exchange of garlands, Home etc and the said marriage is still subsisting. It is to be pointed out that the said ceremony of marriage in between the parties was held at village- Bhadudih, Tola Barkatand, P.O. Damru, P.S. Joypur, Dist- Purulia, and under the jurisdiction of this Ld. Court.
- 2) That at the time of marriage as per demand of the accused persons, father of the complainant paid Rs. 50,000/- along with golden ornament, furniture's, along with other utensils
- 3) That after marriage the complainant was started to reside at her matrimonial house with the accused no-1 as husband and wife and her matrimonial relationship continued and that there were consummated.

- 4) That initially their marriage was really very co-deal but after passage of time when the respondent and his inmates noticed that the complainant failed to give birth any child then they became very much inhuman upon the petitioner and create inhuman torture upon the complainant and started physical as well as mental torture upon her even not spares to be victimized of physical assault and for the pressure of mental as well as physical health of the petitioner deteriorated. However the complainant never mind all utter of the family members and his family members.
- 5) That the complainant informed such incident to her fathers and other inmates, when they went to the matrimonial house of the complainant and somehow console the complainant and setup they relationship the accused prsons and his inmates so that they would not inflected any such torture upon her but to behave with love and affection as their daughter. In-spite of that the respondent and his inmates after few days again started such persistent torture upon the petitioner so long she was at her matrimonial house.
- 6) That the respondent and his family members also demand Rs. 25,000/- to be paid by her father contrary to that they would not keep the petitioner who is to the estimates of the respondent and his family members to be a barren lady and unfit for their family. And ultimately she gave birth a child, However, the

- 10) That since 2nd February the petitioner is residing at paternal house, but the accused persons did not take any information nor they have given any cash or kinds to the complainant and the minor baby and such circumstances the complainant is passing her days in a panic-stricken condition.
- 11) That though the incident was reported to the officer-in-charge of local P.S. and when no legal action was taken by the said Police then another complaint was lodged to the Superintendent of Police Purulia but same fate. Hence the complainant is under compelling circumstances filed this complaint before this Ld. Court under the law.

In the circumstances it is therefore, prayed that your honour may be pleased to send the petition of complaint to the Officer-in-charge, Joypur P.S. treating the same as FIR under section 156(3) for investigation .
