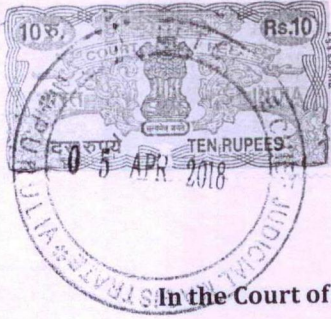

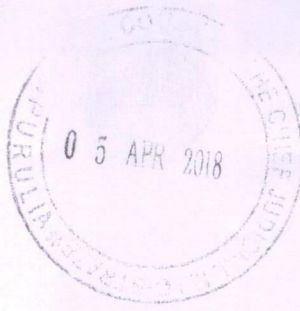

In the matter of an Application u/s 156 (3) Cr.P.C.

The Complainant named above begs to state as follows:-

- 1) That the Complainant was initially inducted as an ordinary monthly tenant under one Ashok Daripa (since Deceased) in the year 2007 on a monthly rental of Rs.600/- per month in respect of one Shop cum Godown situated at P.N.Ghosh Street, Purulia, P.S-Purulia(T), Dist-Purulia within Purulia Municipal Town under Ward no-13, Holding no-502 and was so long in peaceful possession and/or occupation of the same.
- 2) That the Complainant used to store different materials of hardware, sanitary and pipe fittings of his trade in the very premises and still there are such goods worthing more than Rs.1,00,000/- (One Lakh).
- 3) That said Ashok Daripa died on 11/05/2014 and after his death, his widow i.e. the Accused Dipanwita Daripa used to collect the rent from the Complainant on behalf of herself and her two sons.
- 4) That since some time past, the Accused and her two sons were creating pressure upon the Complainant to quit and vacate the rented premises to which the Complainant did not agree.
- 5) That on 15/03/2018 at about 6.30 p.m., when the son of the Complainant i.e. Witness no-2 went to the very shop/Godown with two of their employees, who have been cited as Witness no-3 and 4 of this Complaint, to bring some goods there from to their main business place at Main Road and opened the very store room to bring out the materials, all on a sudden the Accused along with some 5-6 unknown miscreants entered into the very rented room and asked the son and employees of the Complainant to leave the said premises immediately and also declared that she will not allow them to put their locks on the shutter of the room any further.
- 6) That the son of the Complainant i.e. the Witness no-2 then requested the Accused not to do such overt acts and not to take the law in her own hand but the Accused remained strict to her decision and threatened the witness no-2, 3 and 4 of dire consequences, if they do not abide by her direction.

- 7) That the Witness no-2 then directed the witness no-3 and 4 to keep watch upon the shop room from a distance and went back to his main shop room to inform the Complainant.
- 8) That the Complainant having learn the entire fact from his son, went to the Purulia(T) P.S. and lodged a Written Complaint there disclosing the entire facts and Police duly received the said Complaint.
- 9) That after lodging the said Complaint at P.S, the Complainant went back to his main shop at Main Road and sent the Witness no-2 to the said rented premises and accordingly the Witness no-2 at about 8 p.m. went to the very premises and seeing him to come the Accused with the help of her other associates brought down the shutter and put one lock of her own on the very shutter forcibly.
- 10) That the Witness no-2 then tried to protest but the Accused started hurling filthy languages to them when the witnesses seeing no other alternative returned back and informed the entire facts to the Complainant who immediately with the witness no-2 had been to the P.S. and narrated the entire facts to the police officer on duty who assured the Complainant saying that they will take appropriate legal steps against the Accused and thus on good faith and on relying upon the assurance given by the concerned police officer, the Complainant and his son went back.
- 11) That it is of great regret to mention that the police has not taken any action against the Accused till date and for which the Complainant on 26/03/2018 informed the matter to the Superintendent of Police, Purulia but even then as no step has been taken against the Accused Person by the police, the Complainant is being compelled to lodged this Petition u/s 156(3) Cr.P.C. before Your Honour's Court.
- 12) That there are a number of goods worthing more than Rs.1 Lakh stored in that premises and the Complainant naturally apprehends that the Accused may have misappropriate and/or remove the goods there from.
- 13) That due to such overt act, the Complainant has been put to irreparable loss to his business and damages of the goods stored.
- 14) That the Accused Person has thus committed offences punishable u/s 147/341/427/448/451/457/506 I.P.C.
- 15) That the matter requires some seizure of several items stored in the premises and due search of the premises which cannot be possible without police help.
