Nos. 1, 2, 3, 7, 8, 9 and 10 are residents of Station Road, Balarampur, P. O Rangadih, P. S. Balarampur, Dist. Purulia, Nos. 4, 5 and 6 are the residents of Village Beradih, P. S. Balarampur, District Purulia.

The above named complainant most respectfully begs to state as follows;

1. That the complainant and other witnesses cited above are the residents P. S. Balarampur and with the jurisdiction of this Ld. Court.
2. That the complainant, his parents are residing in their residential house at Station Road, Balarampur.
3. That on and from 05. 03. 2018 to 12. 03. 2018 the complainant and his other family members had been Vellore C. M. C. for medical treatment and one Lalit Pramanik, the Witness No. 4, who is well known to the complainant and his family, was asked to stay in the house and to look-after the house in the absence of the complainant and his other family members.
4. That in the late night of 07. 03. 2018 the said Lalit Pramanik informed me that a portion of the house along with some household articles like T. V., Sofa-set, etc. and also the four wheeler vehicle of the complaint have been fully damaged due to fire. Lalit Pramanik also informed me that Fire Brigade was called for and also the Police Personal of Balarampur Police Station were present on the spot and at the intervention of the neighbors the situation was taken into controlled.
5. That as I was not at station, I informed my sister namely Smt. Madhurima Choudhury, the Witness No. 2, to look into the matter immediately.
6. That in the early morning my sister, the witness No. 2 informed the matter in writing to the Officer-in-Charge of Balarampur Police Station.

7. That I came back on 12. 03. 2018 from Vellore and had been to Police Station. It is submitted that in front of my house, there is a School for Kids namely "Sweet Home Nursery" running by one Smt. Suparna Mahato, the witness No. 8 and in that School there is a set up of C. C. TV for surveillance and security of the kids and the said School is situated in the front of my house and is within the range of that C. C. TV. As per my request the Police got the footage of the said C. C. TV of the date of incident from the Witness No. 9 and from which it has been learnt that the incident of fire in my house was not an accident and it has been done by someone with criminal intention.
8. That the Police informed me that one person set fire by sprinkling some liquid in my garage in which my vehicle kept.
9. That it is further submitted that I asked Lalit Pramanik, the witness No. 4 where he was at the time of incident then he disclosed that on the date of incident he was not at my house and in place of him the Witness No. 5 and 6 namely Tapan Pramanik and Prafulla Pramanik were present in my house.
10. That the witnesses named in the complaint petition will prove the statement of the complainant.
11. That due to fire I have lost my valuable household articles and also sustained heavy damage of my residential house. My vehicle damaged badly and is out of use, in total I sustained a loss of Rs. 07, 00, 000/- or more.
12. That it is submitted that the fire was set in by someone in my house with criminal intention which is clearly evident from the C. C. TV footage also, the matter was duly informed to the Police and also the Superintendent of Police, Purulia but till date no specific case has been started and there is no specific investigation of the incident reported to the Police.
13. That me and my other family members are suffering from mental agony and is in fear for the aforesaid incident, as the wrong doer is still out of range of law.
