I SI Amit Masanta (35) S/O- Sukhendu Bikash Masanta, O/C Boro PS do hereby record this case as suomoto against approx 400 unruly mob including Students of Eklabya Model Residential School, Susunia to the effect that today on 04.05.18 at 10:45 hours. I received information from a passenger of a bus who did not disclosed his identity regarding road blockade in front of Eklabya Model Residential School on Manbazar – Bandwan asphalt road via Susunia (SH-05) at Susunia under PS Boro Dist- Purulia. I diarised the information at Boro PS GDE No. 107 at 10:45 hours. Accordingly myself along with ASI Sadhan Ch. Danda, C/994 Srikanta Kumbhakar, C/531 Shib Sankar Mahanti, JC/1021 Ananta Lohar, LC/501 Kakali Pati and LC/609 Amita Jana left PS for Eklabya Model Residential School, Susunia under PS Boro. After reaching there at about 10:55 hours. I found that the road in front of Eklabya Model Residential School, Susunia which runs between Manbazar and Bandwan via Susunia had been blocked by the students of Eklabya Model Residential School, Susunia and some unknown persons from 10:30 hours. They blocked the asphalt road over the issue of physical torture and sexual harassment for long time on umpteen occasions over pleas upon the female students of the said school by a group-D staff of the said school. I found in front of school the students are mixed with the people and hence I talked with the students and the people who had blocked the road and heard their complaints patiently and assured them that all legal steps will be taken against the miscreants involved in physical torture and sexual harassment and all sorts of remedies will be resorted so that no such incident happens in future. I tried to pasify them several times but they did not pay any heed to my request and continued road blocking till 16.00 hours causing in convenience to several passengers and people who were in the on-route busses and vehicles. It was also found that more then 30/35 different types of vehicles loaded with passengers and goods and drivers including patients, minor baby etc. from Boro side and Manbazar side were detained there from 10:30 hrs and subjected to enormous sufferings for a long time. When the people assembling there turned in riotous mood and enhance their agitation vocally to a great extant the entire ambience on the road become very violent, having no other alternative way I declared the mob as unlawful assembly and commanded them to disperse accordingly but the unruly mob continued to be with the unlawful assembly, causing unlawful restraint to the vehicles and passersby and thus generated danger and obstruction in public way. Meanwhile CI Manbazar and SDPO Manbazar with reinforcement and also BDO Manbazar-II, and SDO Manbazar arrived at the spot and after prolonged discussion with the agitators, the agitators lastly withdrew the road blockade at 16:00 hrs and thereafter vehicular traffic became normal. As the students were found mixed with the unruly mob voicing same and there was no chance of segregating them from the mob, so immediate arrest of the unruly mob could not be effected and no lathi charge could not be resorted. On returning to Boro PS I recorded Boro PS Case No-15/18 dated- 04.05.18 U/S 143 /145 /283 /341/ 506 IPC, Read with sec.18 of the west Bengal Highway Act. -1964 and 9 Maintenance of Public Order Act against approx 400 unruly mob including Students of Eklabya Model Residential School, Susunia and directed ASI Tarapada Mete to take up investigation of the case.
