- 3) That as per the demand of the accused persons, the father of your petitioner gave Rs. 1,00,000/- (one Lac in cash with Gold ornaments, furnitures etc.
- 4) That after marriage your petitioner went with her husband and started living there as husband and wife.
- 5) That within some months your petitioner realised that her husband is a habitual drinker and gambler.
- 6) That the accused husband used to earn a handsome amount from brick making business and also he is a tractor driver, but he used to invest most of his income towards consuming alcohol (country made) and gambling, he used to neglect your petitioner by not giving her adequate dresses, foods and even cosmetic items, and for such reasons impleace started between them whenever your petitioner objected against his such immoral activities.
- 7) That the other accused persons used to join hands in tortuching your petitioner mentally and physical ly, nobody of them supported and even loved your petitioner.

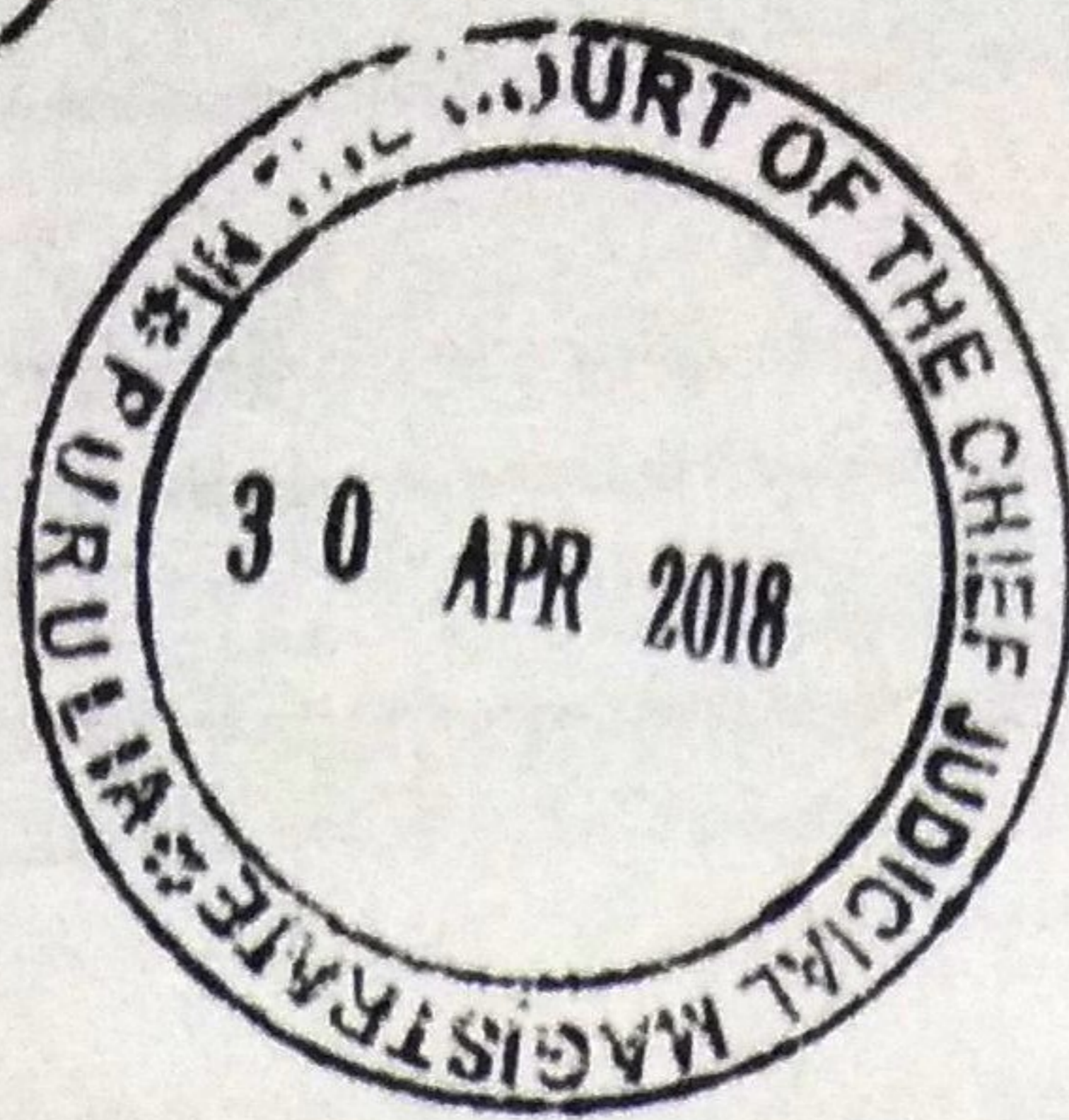
8) That in the course of time out of their wedlock, your petitioner gave birth of two sons namely Mangal and Basudeb presently aged about six years and three years.

9) That all the accused person by making plans used to order your petitioner to bring more moneys from her father with various presentation, some time for starting business by the accused husband, some time for purchasing bike etc. the poor father of your petitioner some time ^{and paid them} managed some amount about 10,000/-, 15,000/- and once Rs. 50,000/- by borrowing privately from his friends, relatives considering it may bring happiness in the life of her beloved daughter, but their greed became limitless day to day.

10) That during last 7/8 years your petitioner lived most of the days in her father's house to avoid tortures, impeace.

11) That before two years in the month of "M A G H" in Bengali Era at 10.P.M. all the accused persons jointly directed her to bring more Rs. 50,000/- from her father for meeting their urgent unknown requirement but this time your petitioner considering her father's poverty denied

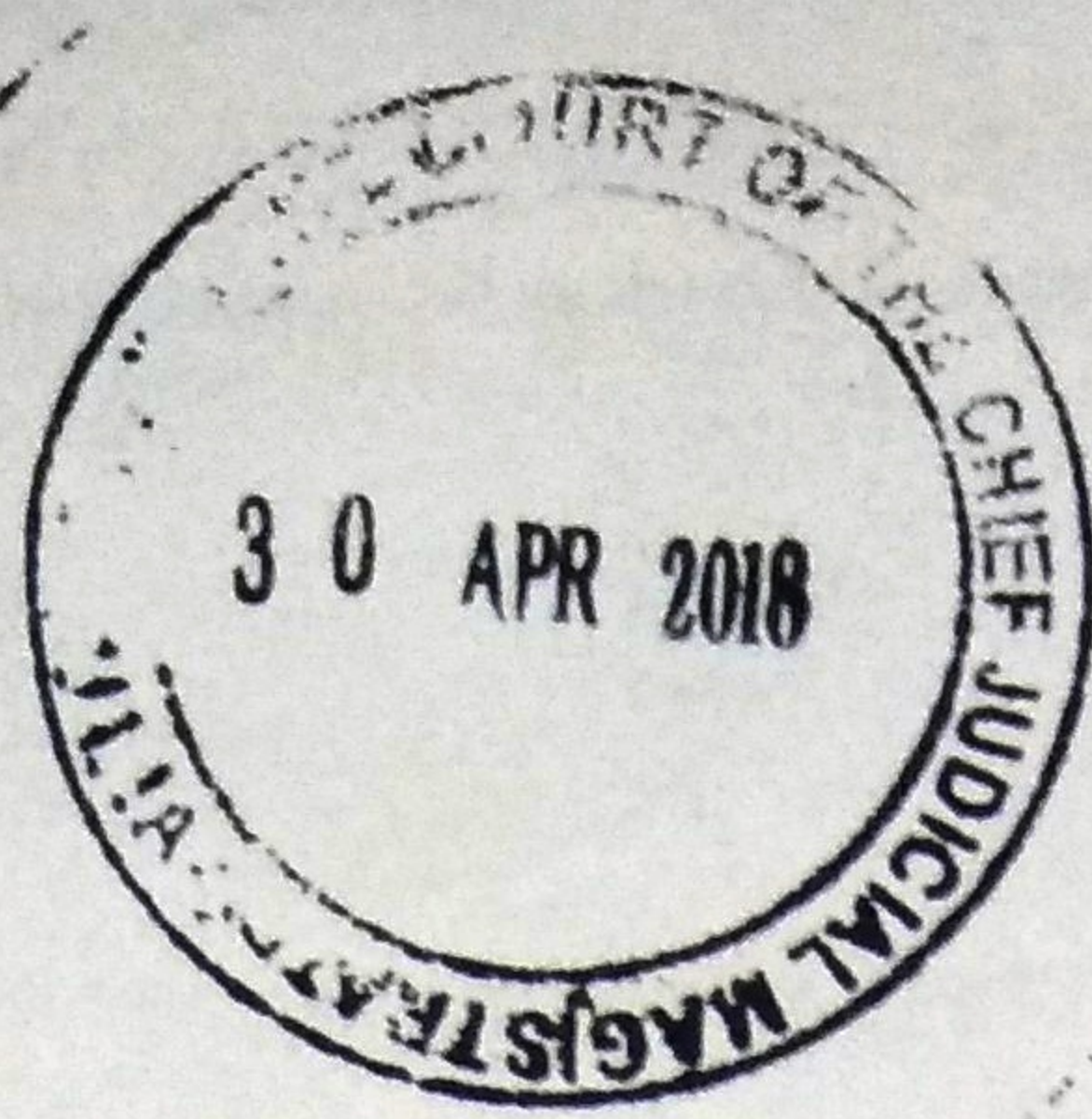
to obey their immoral order when, they all of them pushed your petitioners in a lonely room and started beating her by covering her mouth to stop her from shouting, her ~~father~~ ^{husband} caught her by her hair, accused No.-3 covered her mouth forcefully accused No.-2 and 4, started ~~bitting~~ ^{beating} her mercilessly by fist and blow by legs, by a small thick bamboo and as a result your petitioner falled unconcious.

12) That on the dawn next day the accused persons again beat her and ~~through~~ ^{throw} her out from their home with her one year old son, they forcibely kept her elder son with them.

13) That from that time your petitioner during last two years has been living with her father anticipating a prubable good day when by the mercy of God every thing might be settled.

14) That on 04/04/2018 your petitioner got information that her elder son received a head injury by an accident and she without lossing time rushed to the house of her husband to see her son's condition, but the cruel persons i.e. all the accused persons did not allow her to enter the house, her husband, on the road hit her by a thick

substance on her neck and as a result she fell down on the earth and other accused persons started beating her, to save her life she fled from the place, only by looking her son having bandage on his little head.

15) That your petitioner during last two years used to appear before Jhalda Police station, but regularly the duty officers advised her to get settlement or to go to the court.

16) That being compelled your petitioner filed a complaint before the S.P. Purulia but to no effect.

17) That all the accused persons, in a common intention jointly committed offence punishable under criminal sections.

In these circumstances stated above your complainant prays that your Honour may graciously be pleased to sent this petition to the I.C. Jhalda Police Station for investigation treating this as F.I.R. as contemplated U/s. 156(3) cr.p.c. and starting

a case against the accused persons under appropriate sections or as you may deem fit and proper. - A n d - for which act of kindness your petitioner shall ever pray.
