Most respectfully showeth :-

1. That the marriage between the complainant and  
Accused No.1 was solemnised according to Muslim rites,  
customs and usages on 8/5/2003 at Kanki Bazar in P.S.  
Santal dih, within the jurisdiction of this court  
and that at the time of such marriage as per the  
demand of mainly Accused No.1 to 4 the complainant's  
father had to give Rs. 40,000/- in cash, wrist watch,

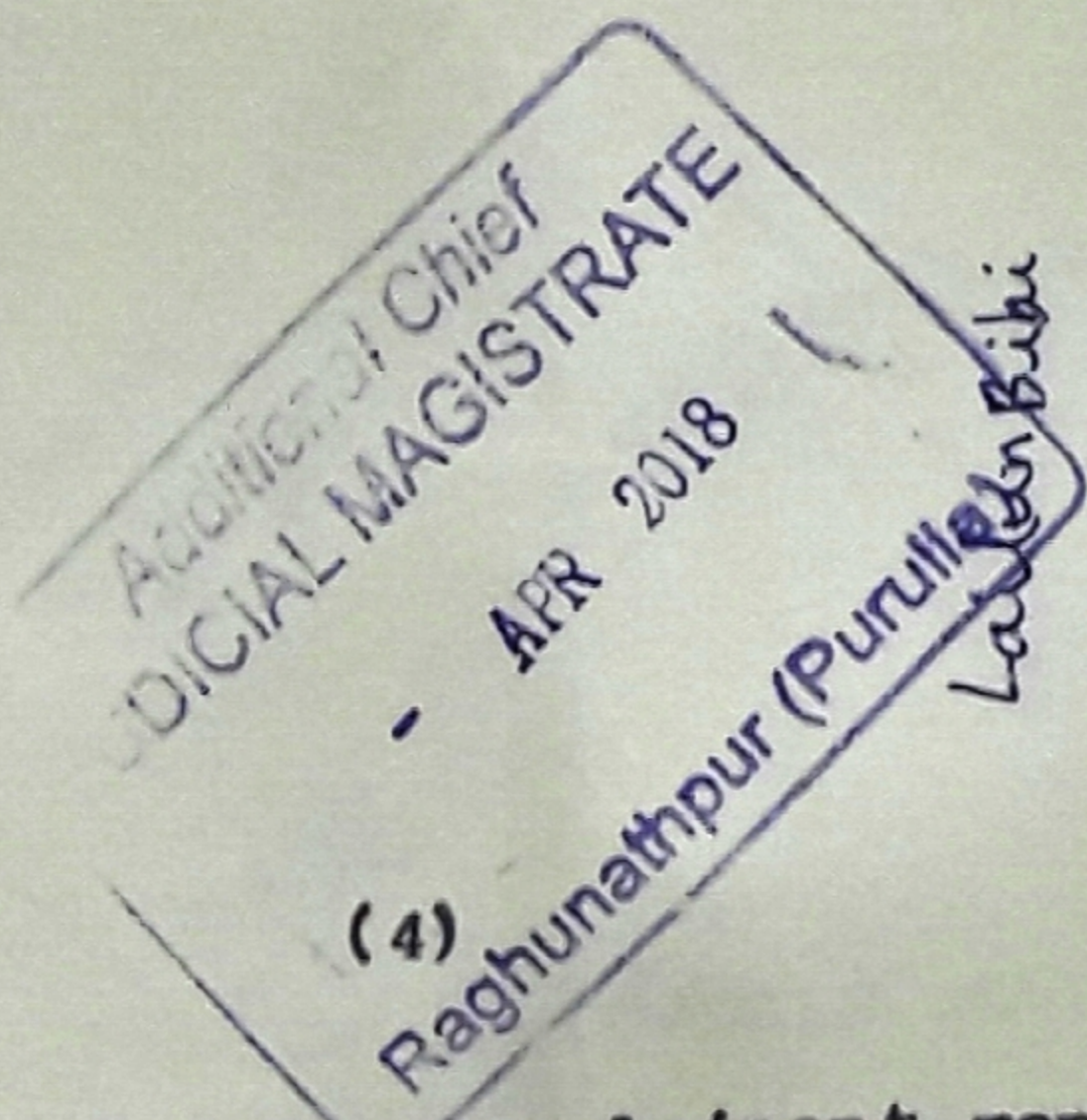
one Avon cycle, one Gold Ring and other several household articles to accused No.1 in presence of the witnesses including Accused Nos. 1 to 4 and the same was received by the accused persons in writing.

2. That the complainant after such marriage went to the matrimonial house with her husband namely, Accused No.1 and started living with Accused No.1 as husband and wife along with complainant's two brothers and their wives.

3. That it is irony of fate that <sup>after</sup> one month of such marriage accused No.1 at the instance of the accused Nos. 2 to 4 told the complainant to bring Rs.20,000/- from her father to which the complainant refused to do so whereupon Accused Nos. 1 to 4 started torturing the complainant both mentally and physically on several ways. It is pertinent to mention that subsequently complainant's husband's younger brother Accused Murteja Ansary got married with Accused No.5 Nasrin Bibi and all the <sup>5</sup> accused persons thereafter started torturing the complainant both mentally and physically due to non-fulfilment of their unlawful demand of Rs.20,000/-.

4. That the complainant reported the incident of unlawful demand <sup>and tortures</sup> to her father namely witness No.2 who on hearing so expressed before the Accused persons as to his inability to fulfil their unlawful demand and he also requested the accused persons not to torture the complainant but to allow her to lead conjugal life at the matrimonial home. It is pertinent to mention that for the sake of happy conjugal life of the complainant her father gave Rs.5000/- to accused No.1 on 1/10/2012 in presence of some witnesses and apart from that said witness Safir Ansary satisfied the Accused No.1 as to the demand according to his capacity at times.

5. That in this way days, months and years rolled on and the complainant out of lawful wed-lock with accused No.1 begot 2 sons namely, Hussain Ansary aged about 14 years and Arman Ansary, aged about 11 years. It is painful to state that inspite of issue 2 male children the accused persons did not give up their nature and habits. They went on demanding as well as torturing upon the complainant.

6. That on 19/03/2018 at about 8.00 A.M. all the the 5 Accused persons again told the complainant to bring Rs.20,000/- from her father to which the complainant being frustrated and disgusted protested whereupon all the accused persons in a joint concert brutally assaulted the complainant by fists and blows kicks and slaps and thereafter they ousted the complainant and her 2 sons from the matrimonial home after keeping all her stridhans.

7. That it is pertinent to mention that at the active instance of accused Nos. 2 to 5 the accused No.1 in a preplanned way took one Tanu Khatun, D/o Kalam Ansary of Kanki Bazar on 20/03/2018 and thereafter left Kanki Bazar and started living elsewhere as husband and wife illegally.

8. That the complainant went to Santaldih P.S. on the following day, i.e., on 22/03/2018 and lodged a written F.I.R. detailing the demand of money, tortures and taking away said Tanu Khatun etc. to which the duty officer assured to take necessary action against the 5 accused persons but

ultimately of no result and as such being frustrated the complainant informed the matter before the Supdt. of Police, Purulia on 5/4/2018 in writing but it is painful to state that although about a month elapsed neither the Santaldih P.S. nor the S.P. Purulia took any proper step against the 5 accused persons. Hence this complainant being helpless has been obliged to file this complaint petition u/s 156(3) Cr.P.C. before the Id. court for relief and justice.

It is therefore prayed that the I/C, Santaldih P.S. may kindly be directed to investigate the case u/s 156(3) Cr.P.C. treating the complaint as F.I.R.
