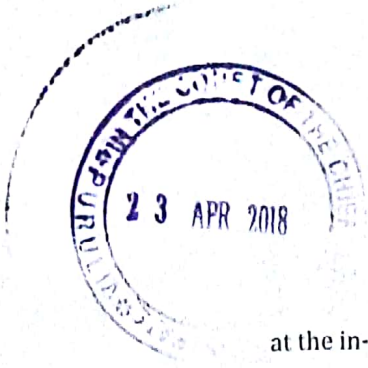

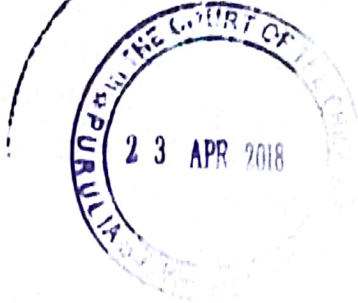

The Complainant named above begs to state as follows:-

- 1) That the Complainant is the legally married wife of the Accused no-1 and their marriage was solemnized in the year 2009 at Vill-Sonadaha, P.S-Barabazar, Dist-Purulia in accordance to the Hindu Laws of Marriage and

- the rites and customs prevailing in their society and after the marriage the Complainant went to her in-laws house at Vill & P.O-Ariyachirudih, P.S-Kamalpur, Dist-East-Singbhum, Jharkhand and started residing there with the Accused no-1 as husband and wife and the marriage tie still subsists.
- 2) That at the time of marriage, as per the demand of all the Accused Persons, the father of the De-facto Complainant (Witness no-2) had to pay cash of Rs. 60,000/-, Gold Ornaments weighing 2 varies, Furniture, one Hero By-Cycle, Mobile Phone, and other utensils towards the dowry.
 - 3) That after marriage the Complainant was almost well in her in-laws house for a very short period, but soon thereafter all the Accused Persons started creating persistent pressure upon the Complainant to ask her father to pay them a further sum of Rs. 60,000/- towards additional dowry as the dowry paid at the time of marriage was much less than their expectation. The Complainant on all such occasions used to tell them that her father being a poor man could any how manage the dowry amount at the time of marriage but it is quite impossible for him to meet-up any such further demand of the her husband and members of her in-laws family.
 - 4) That the reply as aforesaid given by the Complainant made the members of her in-laws family very much annoyed as a result of which they started to ill treat and torture the Complainant both physically and mentally. They often used to pick up quarrel with the Complainant even on a negligible domestic affairs and often used to stop supplying adequate food and clothing to her. She often used to be beaten by all the Accused Persons even on flimsy grounds.
 - 5) That as the Complainant was not blessed with any child, all the Accused Persons openly used to blame the Complainant saying her a 'Banjha woman' and openly used to declare that they will arrange for the second marriage of her husband and for the purpose the Complainant will soon be driven out from the residence. Though on several occasions the Complainant requested the Accused no-1 for medical treatment of both of them but on all such occasions the Accused no-1 used to ignore her such proposal. Subsequently in the month of Asharh, 1424 B.S.(Last part of the month of June, 2017) the Accused no-1 being instigated by the other

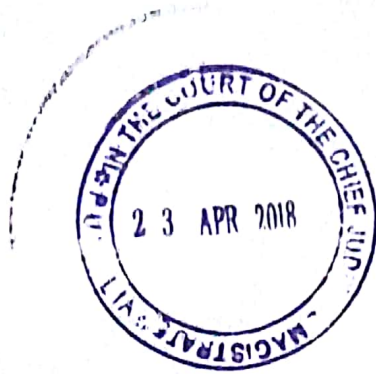

Accused Persons took the Complainant with him and kept her at her parental house on the plea that as she is ailing so she should have a short rest and he at that time assured the Complainant and her parents that he will take her back soon.

- 6) That the Complainant on good faith relied on such version of the accused no-1 and stayed at her parental house for a considerable period of 6 months. But surprisingly enough that during that period neither the Accused no-1 nor any of the other accused persons visited the parental house of the Complainant. On the contrary they started to avoid the Complainant. He even did not receive the phone call of the Complainant. The Accused no-1 subsequently stopped attending the phone calls of the Complainant and her parents.
- 7) That the father of the Complainant and other members of her family on several occasions had been to the house of the Accused Persons to make her husband as well as other members of his family agreed to bring the Complainant back to their house but for no good. The Accused Persons on all those occasions on various false pleas and pretexts used to drag the very matter.
- 8) That on the first part of the January, 2018, the Complainant and her family members came to know from some reliable sources that the Accused no-1, with the active instigation of the other Accused Persons, was going to marry one another woman very soon. On hearing such news the Complainant and her other family members became astonished and immediately the father of the Complainant and some of her other family members had been to the house of the Accused Persons and inquired about the matter. The Accused Persons then clearly denied and informed them that it is just a rumor and nothing else and they also in presence of the father of the Complainant and his other associates stated that the Accused no-1 would surely go to the parental house of the Complainant to bring her back within one month. On being assured by the Accused Persons, the Father and other relatives of the Complainant returned back.
- 9) That it should be mentioned here that on 25/01/2018 corresponding to 11th day of Magh, 1424 B.S. at about 10 p.m. the Accused No-1 along with

some unknown persons came to the parental house of the Complainant in drunken condition and all on a sudden started abusing the Complainant and her parents and other family members in filthy languages. He straightway declared that he would surely marry another woman as early as possible and he would not take the Complainant back to her life any further as the Complainant is a 'Banjha Woman'. When the Complainant and her family members protested against such act and ill behaviour of the Accused no-1, he started assaulting the Complainant mercilessly with fists and blows and caught hold her neck with intention to kill the Complainant. On hearing hue and cry, when the witnesses no-4 to 6, the neighbours and other family members reached the spot, the Accused no-1 and his associates fled away from there. The Complainant any how saved her life.

- 10) That in the 7th day of March, 2018 the Complainant came to know that the Accused no-1 with the active participation of the other Accused Persons married once again with one another woman namely Smt. Kajal Mahato, d/o Sri Lambodar Mahato of Vill & P.O-Birrah, P.S-Kamalpur, Dist-East-Singbhum, Jharkhand on 27/02/2018 corresponding to 14th day of Falgun, 1424 B.S. and is residing with that lady at his native house as husband and wife.
- 11) That immediately after hearing such news, the Complainant along with her other family members on 08/03/2018 had been to the house of the Accused Person but the Accused Persons did not allow them to enter into their house and started abusing them with filthy languages. They also threatened them of dire consequences if they dare to stay there any further. The Complainant and her relatives then having no alternative left, returned back.
- 12) That returning there from, the Complainant, her father and others had been to Kamalpur P.S. on that day and informed the matter in details there to the police officer present in the P.S. but the concerned police officer refused to take any Complaint on the plea of absence of Jurisdiction. Subsequently the Complainant and her father had been to Barabazar P.S. on 10/03/2018 to lodge a FIR and the police officer, on duty after hearing about the incident narrated by the Complainant, assured the Complainant and her companions that they will take appropriate steps and measures against the Accused

Persons and on getting such assurance the Complainant, her father and others went back to their residence.

- 13) That after waiting for a considerable period when the Complainant found that the police of Barabazar P.S. practically has not taken any step whatsoever against the Accused Persons, the Complainant on 22/03/2018 submitted a Written Complaint before the Superintendent of Police, Purulia but even in spite of all these endeavors of the Complainant, no step has been taken by the police and as such the Complainant is being compelled to lodge this Petition u/s 156(3) Cr.P.C. before Your Honour's Court.
- 14) That thus the Accused Persons have committed offences with the Complainant and are liable to be prosecuted accordingly.
- 15) That the Complainant is a poor rustic villager and it is quite impossible for her to arrange for collecting evidences in this regard without the help of police machineries and it is also impossible for her to bear the cost of the case.

It is therefore prayed that Your Honour may be graciously pleased to send this Complaint to the O.C, Barabazar P.S. with a direction to investigate into the matter treating this Written Complaint as F.I.R.
