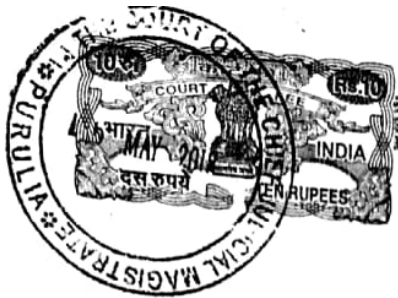

Nos. 1 to 3 are the residents of Village- Dumdumi, P.S.- Purulia(M), District- Purulia, while No.4 is the resident of Napitpara (Near Dhobghata), P.S.- Purulia (T), District- Purulia. and others.

The humble petition on behalf of the complainant - petitioner;

Most respectfully sheweth :-

1. That, your petitioner happens to be the legally married wife of Accused No.1 and the rest accused are the in-laws of the petitioner.
2. That, the marriage between the petitioner and the accused No.1 was a negotiated one and the same was solemnised at the father's house of the petitioner at Village- Dumdumi, P.S.- Purulia(M), District- Purulia on 30/01/2012 corresponding to 15th Magh, 1418 B.S. with due observance of all the rites and rituals prevalent in their community.

3. That, pursuant to the demand so made on the side of the accused the poor father of the petitioner had to give a sum of Rs. 70,000/- (Rupees seventy thousand) only in cash to the opposite party besides gold ornaments weighing about 3 bhories to the petitioner ~~Next~~ and other articles like furniture such as wooden cot, iron made almira, one big size colour T.V. and utensils.

4. That, after the marriage the petitioner stepped into her matrimonial house with a lot of hopes and dreams locked into heart and started her conjugal life with the opposite party there amidst other inmates. She was kept and maintained well there by the accused Nos. 1 to 9 for at most a month or so and thereafter she found herself in a most ungraceful atmosphere as all the inmates started humiliating her making comments like "daughter of a beggar" "uncultured as to and ugly looking" etc. with the comment that the father of the petitioner had cheated them by giving in marriage of an ugly looking lady in their rich family. The accused Nos. 2 to 9 of the house even instigated the accused No.1 to beat the petitioner and accordingly the accused No.1 used to do so.

5. That, one of the elder brothers of the accused No.1 (cousin) namely Bhadari Kaibartya (accused No.6) used to make ill-proposal to the petitioner to which the petitioner made complaint to the accused No.1 with a request to ask his elder brother not to do so but the accused No.1 instead of taking serious exception to such conduct of

his elder brother used to assault the petitioner mercilessly. However, the petitioner did not have any other option but to take all these lying down in anticipation of prospective happiness.

6. That, the petitioner in a year thereafter gave birth to a female baby at her matrimonial house. She was suffering from pangs of child birth and despite her request got her admitted in hospital which is at most 2 k.m. away therefrom, the accuseds did not make such arrangement and deliberately compelled the petitioner to travail at the house without medical assistance. At the advent of the female child in the house the accused Nos. 1 to 9 got very much displeased and started blaming the petitioner for her giving birth to a female baby making her liable for the same. Following the same the torture upon the petitioner was escalated by the accused Nos. 1 to 9.

7. That, after the lapse of about a year the petitioner got conceived for the second time and during the advanced stage of pregnancy when the petitioner was suffering from various complications including anaemia she was never taken to hospital and on that occasion too she was forced to give birth to the baby staying at the house making her to suffer near death experience. This time she gave birth to a male baby.

8. That, the petitioner after giving birth to a male baby thought that since that time she has given birth to a male child accused Nos. 1 to 9 would be happy and she would be

be treated well by them but as ill luck would have it accused No.1 instead of showing love and sympathy towards her started demanding Rs. 50,000/- asking the petitioner to procure the said sum from her parents with a saying that unless the petitioner procures the said sum how he would increase his business of fish selling and how the children would be benefited.

The petitioner expressed her inability to procure the said sum and resultantly torture upon her was continued by the ~~acc~~ accused . The accused and the other inmates used to threaten the petitioner to kill her by poisoning. The attempt to kill the petitioner having been foisted the accused Nos. 1 to 9 drove the petitioner out of her matrimonial house last on 07/03/2015 and thereafter your petitioner had got a complaint registered before the Purulia(M) P.S.

9. That, during the stay of the petitioner at her father's house at Dumdum the accused No.1 after much persuasion got the petitioner agreed to return to her matrimonial house to resume conjugal life with him on the assurance that she would be kept well there with proper dignity and being swayed by such assurance your petitioner, with a view to resuming conjugal life went back to her matrimonial house last on 21/01/2018 alongwith her children.

10. That, for about one month or so she was kept and

maintained well and thereafter pressure upon her again created for procurement of additional dowry and ultimately due to non-fulfilment of said demand she was again driven out therefrom on 25/03/2018.

11. That, thereafter your petitioner and other witness got information on 25/04/2018 that accused No.1 in the mean time got married for the second time with accused No.10 on 13/04/2018. The marriage ceremony took place in the house of the accused Nos. 11 and 12 who happen to be the parents of accused No.10. During this marriage all the rites and rituals were held and performed as prevalent in their society.

12. That, thereafter your petitioner in order to verify the said fact had been to her matrimonial house on 27/04/2018 alongwith the rest witnesses and on reaching there found in reality that accused No.10 was there as the newly wedded wife of accused No.1.

13. That, your petitioner thereafter had been to the Purulia(M) P.S. on the selfsame date i.e. on 27/04/2018 and lodged complaint therewith but as even after the lapse of a week no case had been registered by the P.S. your petitioner informed the matter in writing to the Superintendent of Police, Purulia last on 03/05/2018 but to no effect.
