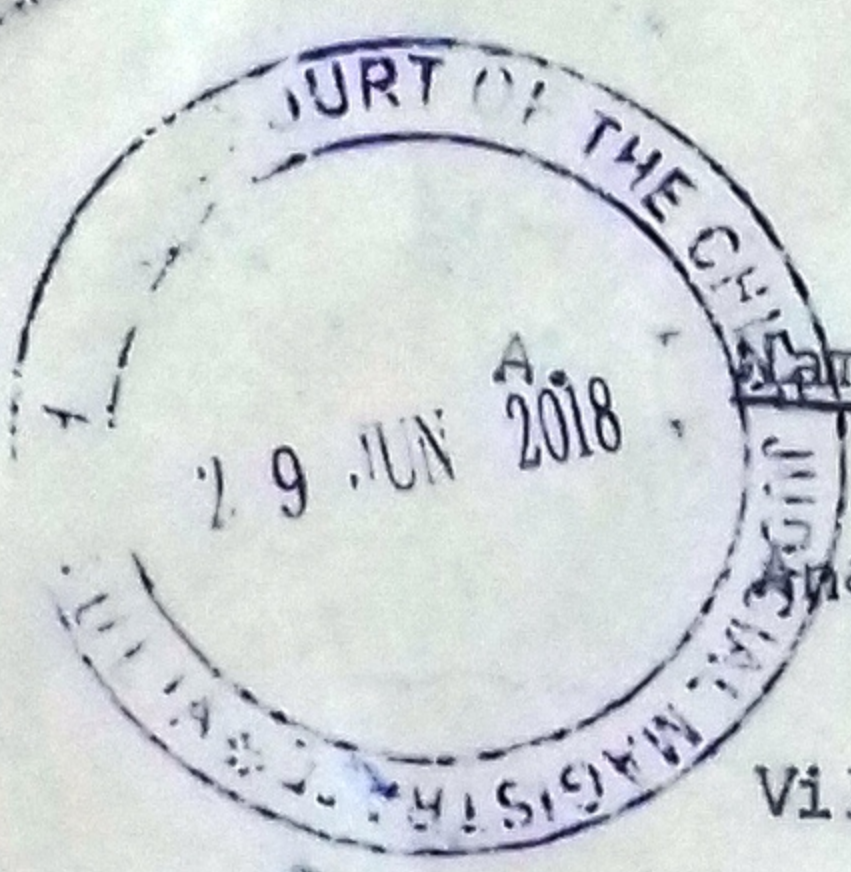

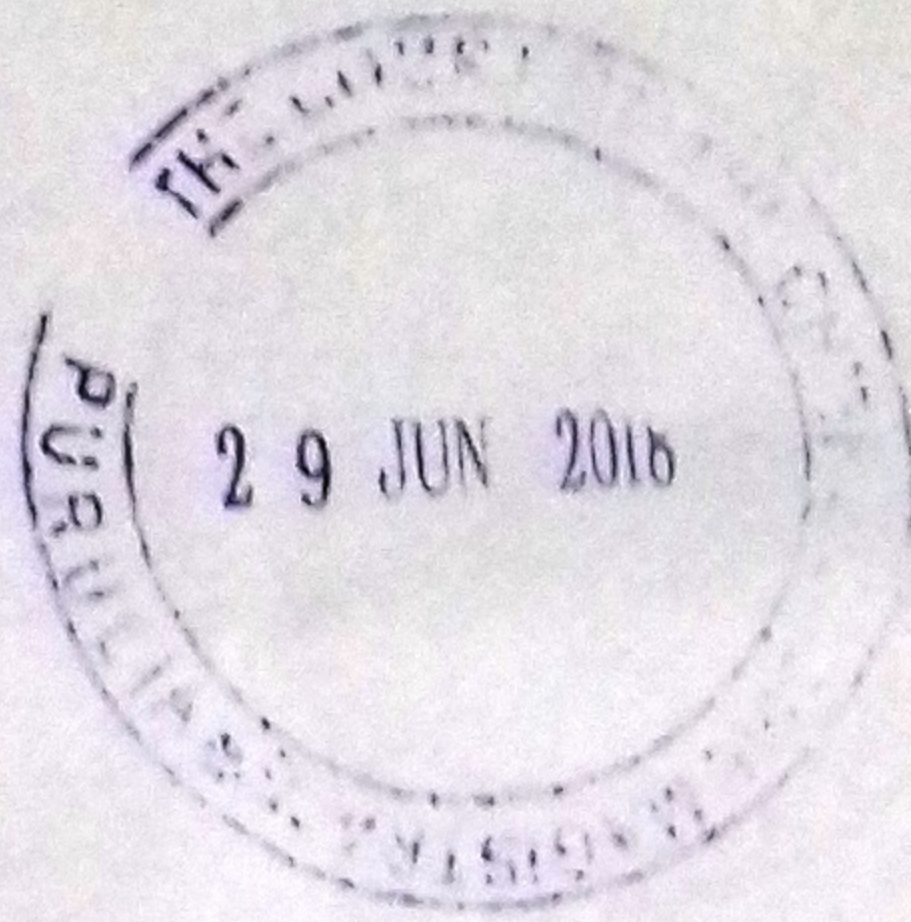

The above-named complainant begs to state as follows:-

1...That the complainant is a employee in a shop belongs to the witness Dipak Mura .Dipak is none else but the

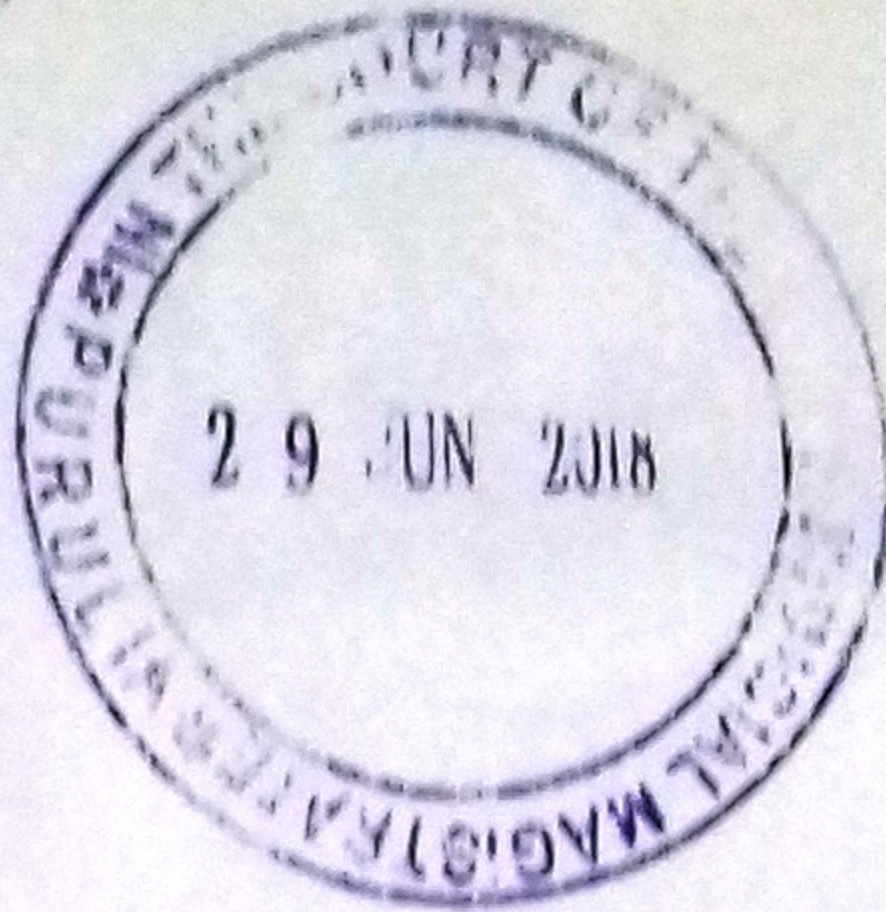

full brother of the accused Naren Mura.

2...That in between Dipak and Naren long standing family dispute is/was continuing with regard to their ancestral properties when Naren claimed the shop room but the said Dipak did not allow the said Naren and accordingly accused Naren finding no other alternative asked the complainant not to work in the shop of Dipak and in that case Dipak alone will not able to run the said shop and than Dipak shall shut down the shop. But as the complainant did not pay any heed of the threatening of the accused person than the accused some days back prior to the incident again threatened the complainant the complainant that unless the complainant leave the shop of said Dipak in that case he would be murder the complainant.

3...That on the date of occurrences, i.e. on 22.1.2018 the complainant as usual was sleeping in the shop room of said Dipak Mura and in the dead of night the said accused Naren Mura knocked the door of shop room asked the complainant to come out for an urgent matter and when the complainant after opening the door come out

than the accused Naren Hansda all on a sudden assaulted the complainant on his head causing bleeding injuries and fingers of his right hand causing fracture and other parts of his body with the help of iron rod. The accused with a view to cause death of the complainant assaulting him on the vital part of the body but the life of the complainant was saved.

4...That after assaulted the complainant became senseless and after regaining his sense he called the local people and he was shifted to Pathardih Hospital for treatment and thereafter he was admitted at Uday Polyclinic Ortho Centre at Ranchi for better management.

6....That after the complainant returned back he reported to the matter to the officer-in-charge Baghmundi Police Station in writing and also handed over the Xerox copy of the injury report and thereafter on several dates the complainant met the police and enquired about his case and all those times though police assured but ultimately no such legal action has taken against the accused

Most probably due to some political pressure as the accused is under the shelter of particular political party .

6...That thereafter the complainant reported the incident to the Superintendent of Police but with same fate. And ultimately the complainant is compelled to file this Complaint before the Ld. Court under the law.

In this circumstances stated herein above your Honour may be pleased to send this complaint before the Officer-in-charge Baghmundi P.S. for registering the specific case and to proceed with investigation and treating the same as F.I.R. U/s 156(3) Cr.P.C.
