The humble petition of the complainant

Most respectfully showeth :-

1. That the marriage between the complainant and the accused was solemnised according to Hindu rites, customs and usages prevalent in their community on 02/08/2005 at the complainant's paternal residence at Village-Palma aforesaid in presence of their relatives and well wishers and it is pertinent to mention that at the time of such marriage complainant's father, as per the demand of the accused, gave cash of Rs. 1,00,000/-, cloths and utensils made of Bel metal to the accused towards bridal gifts.

2. That after such marriage the complainant went to her matrimonial home with the accused at Village Palma aforesaid and started living together as husband and wife.

3. That the complainant was more or less well for about a year but thereafter the accused told the complainant to bring Rs. 50,000/- from her father but the latter considering her father's financial unsoundness refused and protested whereupon the accused started torturing the complainant both mentally and physically on different ways. The complainant reported the entire incidents of illegal demand of dowry as well as torture to her father and other relatives and well wishers who on hearing so advised the complainant to brook and to lead conjugal life at the matrimonial home with a hope that the accused would change his nature and habits in due course of time.

4. That out of such lawful wed-lock the complainant begot a male child namely, Muruli Bouri now aged about 13 years and subsequently begot a female child Koishalya now aged about 7 years but it is irony of fate that after the birth of female child the accused started pressing the complainant off and on to bring Rs. 50,000/- and when the complainant expressed her inability the accused used to torture the complainant both mentally and physically with higher scale and the accused also used to tell that he would remarry after driving out the complainant.

That on 20/05/2018 the accused brought one married woman namely, Sagari Mal, w/o Sri Bablu Mal (D/o Sri Santosh Bouri) of Village-Banberia in P.S.Para, District Purulia to the matrimonial home and started living with her illegally to which the complainant protested the accused's illegal acts whereupon the accused not only brutally assaulted the complainant on her person on her different parts of the body but also finally on 23/05/18 at about 7 A.M. the accused again ^{demanding Rs 50000/- and thereafter the accused} assaulted the complainant brutally and he drove the complainant and her son and daughter aforesaid from the matrimonial home keeping her all stridhans illegally and as such the complainant being quite helpless came to her paternal house at the same village at Palma aforesaid and told the entire episodes to her father and others and thereafter the complainant lodged a written F.I.R. against the accused before Para P.S. on the same date, i.e. on 23/05/2018 to which the duty Police officer assured to take necessary action against the accused but to no result and as such the complainant reported the matter to the Superintendent of Police, Purulia through Postal speed post on 30/05/2018 enclosing the copy of written F.I.R. dated 23/05/2018 for initiating proper action against the accused but it is painful to state that about a month has elapsed but neither the Para P.S. nor the S.P.Purulia took any action against the offences so far committed by the accused.
