Sir,

Herewith submitting a written complaint to the effect that on 18/08/18 while I was performing anti crime evening mobile duty at the PS area, in between 18:00 hrs to 19:00 hrs I received a telephonic source information that in Baghadabor village under Adra PS some persons are illegally stocking I.D liquor with a view to sell at higher costs without any valid license or document. I SI Parikshit Maitra along with C/122 Rabindra Kr Verma and C/201 Rabindranath Nag left for holding raid at the said village in Govt. Vehicle after informing the matter to O/C Adra PS. At about 19:30 hrs we reached near Baghadabor. I got information from local public that I.D liquor is being sold rampantly in Mahali Para of Baghadabor, PS-Adra. When I reached at Mahali Para I saw some persons drinking liquor openly in public. Then we went near those persons to identify the place or person from where the I.D liquor was being sold. When we asked them their identity they became infuriated and started throwing slang languages at us. Then I tried to pacify them but they did not pay any heed and started calling other villagers. Suddenly, about 50/60 villagers equipped with lathi, Bamboos etc gathered and surrounded us and they started abusing us and tried to shove us down to the ground. The mob was leaded by (1) Kalicharan Ruidas S/O Lt. Santosh Ruidas (2) Dharam mahali S/O Dugai Mahali (3) Sonil Mahali S/O Vutka Mahali (4) Nakul Mahali S/O Daru Mahali (5) Amrit Mahali S/O Sahadeb Mahali (6) Nepal Ruidas S/O Lt. Santosh Ruidas (7) Sanaka Mahali W/O Sunil Mahali (8) Chinta Mahali W/O Nakul Mahali All are village Baghadabor Mahali Para (9) Raju Moni S/O Lt. Jiten Moni (10) Naba Karmakar S/O Krishnapada Karmakar (11) Ganesh Karmakar S/O Lt. Fani Karmakar Ali are village Baghadabor, PS-Adra, Dist-Purulia and few others. Seeing that the situation growing precarious, we tried to get into our Govt. vehicle vide R/C No- WB 56C-8738 but they started to pull us and even they tried to snatch my loaded revolver. But somehow we were able to get into the vehicle and our police driver started the vehicle to escape but they tried to stop us from leaving the place by obstructing the road by throwing bamboos and creating human barrier. Then some villagers started throwing bricks and started hitting the vehicle as per provocation of the above noted persons, trying to seriously injure us so that we do not leave the village. During this the vehicle got severely damaged and even the back windshield of the vehicle shattered into pieces. Then anyhow we escaped from the village and informed the matter to O/C Adra PS. After some time additional officers and force and then we jointly started raid at the village but found none of the accused persons were present at the village. We also raided at adjacent villages i.e. Meryala, Gopinathpur, Sanka, Bhagaipur etc to arrest the accused persons but could not trace out them. Then we started for PS.

I, therefore, pray that a specific case may kindly be started against the above noted 11 accused persons along with 50/60 others for obstructing police from doing their duty and damaging Govt. property under proper sections of law and to arrange for its proper investigation.
