I, SI Mukul Karmakar, In-Charge of Suisa OP, PS-Baghmundi, do here by lodge complaint against accused persons namely 1. Kaibarta, C/307 Imtiyaj Khan, C/314 Chandan Ghosh, C/763 Subrata Kr. Paul, C/352 Tanmoy Ghosh, C/348 Rajendra Krishna, Das all of 13th Bn. Camp at Suisa OP under Baghmundi P.S and JLC/1155 Jotshna Mahato of Baghmundi P.S vide Suisa OP C.C No.-845, Dtd: 27.08.18 performing law and order duty in c/w Formation of Gram Panchayet Board of Tunturi -Suisa GP in front of the GP Office main gate, suddenly formed an unlawfully assembly under the leadership of Bibhuti Rajak, Gopal Mahato, Panchanan Rajak and became unruly by violating the order U/S-144(2) of Cr.P.C 1973 ordered by Sub-Divisional Magistrate, Jhalda dated 24.08.18 being armed with lathi, rod started pelting stone and brickbats towards Police personals when the officials of the GP and Baghmundi Block come out from the Tunturi -Suisa GP Office after selection of Pradhan


and Upa-Pradhan from BJP of the said GP. The matter inform to O/C Baghmundi P.S and C.I Balarampur for reinforcement. Accordingly officers and force persuade to the unruly mob to control the situation but they did not paid any heed. It was found that the supporters (Male & Female) of BJP and FB were very much excited and created hallah, uttering slang languages to create serious pandemonium. In the mean time at about 15:00 hrs O/C Baghmundi P.S along with force reached at the spot for reinforcement. When O/C Baghmundi P.S along with force get down from the vehicle a group of violent mob attacked upon him and assaulted O/C Baghmundi P.S SI Anup Ghosh and JC/740 Subhendu Satpati of Suisa OP, and a group of supporters broke the lock of Tunturi Suisa GP Office gate and forcibly entered into the office by over powering Police and destroyed important files, papers, broke office articles i.e Table, Chair, Almirah as well as lit fire upon some important files and papers as well as stole away some office goods and papers. Then O/C Baghmundi P.S declared the said mob as unlawfull assembly and after then the Officers and forces were also trying to their level best to maintain peace but all the efforts ended in vain. Rather they became extremely out of control. Finding no any other alternative O/C Baghmundi P.S, and other officers requested them to disperse from the spot. But the agitated mob did not bother that. As per order of O/C Baghmundi P.S, Purulia we had to use minimum force by lathi to disperse the agitated mob. However we could not be able to detain anyone from the spot. I seized 1) Some half burnt papers, 2) Broken Red Colour Plastic Chair, 3) One broken wooden table, 4) 06 pcs Bamboo Sticks in different length, 5) 12 pcs Bricksbats, 6) One broken lock, 7) 02 pcs Iron Rod having length approx 03 ft seized from the PO. Due to unavailability of public witness I have to prepare seizure list duly signed by my accompanying staff. Both of injured were medically treated.

As such the persons noted above have committed an offence punishable U/S- 147/148/149/332/353/379/186/188/323/325/307/509/427/435 IPC read with sec 9 of MPO Act and Sec 3 and 4 of PDPP Act against the above noted accused persons and arrange for its investigation.
