The humble Complaint on behalf of the Complainant:-

Most respectfully sheweth:-

- That, the complainant along with his other family members have been residing at village Srirampur, P.S. Joypur, Dist. Purulia.
- That, the accused persons are next door neighbours of the complainant. The accused persons have been creating problems with the complainant since last couple of years so as to grab their landed property. Be it mentioned that at the instance of accused no. 6, a proceeding U/S 145 of Cr.P.C. was instituted against the complainant and two other brother before the Ld. S.D.E.M. and the same is still pending adjudication.
 - That on the date of occurance, since noon 4 P.M. 3. the accused persons had been uttering filthy themsethreats amiming the complainant and his family members.
 - That, the complainant did not pay any heed to such threats. However at about 4 P.M., all the accused






persons forming an unlawful assembly and being variously armed with Lathi, iron rod etc., criminally tresspassed into the courtyard of the complainant and started creating pandemonium. Hearing this hue and cry, complainant came out on the courtyard and as he raised his feebel voice of protest, all the accused persons had genraced and while accused nos. 3 to 6 and cought hold of him, accused no.1 and 2 being instigated by other accused persons made a murderous assault on him and blows landed on his head, causing severe bleeding injuries.

- 5. That, the complainant had sustained injuries and collapsed on the ground and the witnessess had arrived at the spot and at their intervention life of the complainant was saved.
- 6. That, the accused persons had at the time of encircling the complainant had been uttering that he should not be spared and should be . dome away with.
- 7. That, the accused persons in furtherance of their common object had attempted to commit culpable homicide, no not amounting to murder. Accused persons took to their heels on arrival of witnesses.



- 8. That, after the occurance, the complainant was removed to jJoypur P.S. by his family members, where he had intimated all about the incident but the Police officer had assured him to take appropriate steps and had issued a piece of document, referring him to B.P.H.C., Joypur.
- 9. That, the complainant was initially treated at Joypur B.P.H.C. and later he was referred to Sadar Hospital, Purulia, where he was admitted as an indoor patient in male Surgical Ward and was treated as an indoor patient.
- 10. That, after his discharge, complainant had on number of occasions, visited Joypur P.S. to gather information about his complaint made on 08.05.2018 but all the time he was send back with prevaricating pleas.
- 11. That the complainant on querry, could also gathered that no F.I.R. over his complaint had been received at the G.R. Section.
- 12. That, the complainant had thereafter submitted a written representation in the office of the S.P. Purulia on 09.07.2018, but k no positive response has been received.
