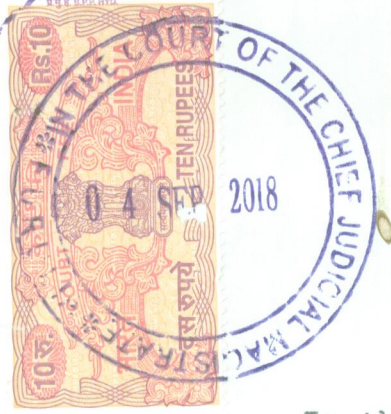

the Complainant:-

Most respectfully sheweth:-

1. That, the complainant along with his other family members have been residing at village Srirampur, P.S. Joypur, Dist. Purulia.
2. That, the accused persons are next door neighbours of the complainant. The accused persons have been creating problems with the complainant since last couple of years so as to grab their landed property. Be it mentioned that at the instance of accused no. 6, a proceeding U/S 145 of Cr.P.C. was instituted against the complainant and two other brother before the Ld. S.D.E.M. and the same is still pending adjudication.
3. That on the date of occurrence, since noon 4 P.M. the accused persons had been uttering filthy ~~these~~ threats aiming the complainant and his family members.
4. That, the complainant did not pay any heed to such threats. However at about 4 P.M., all the accused

8. That, after the occurrence, the complainant was removed to Joypur P.S. by his family members, where he had intimated all about the incident but the Police officer had assured him to take appropriate steps and had issued a piece of document, referring him to B.P.H.C., Joypur.
9. That, the complainant was initially treated at Joypur B.P.H.C. and later he was referred to Sadar Hospital, Purulia, where he was admitted as an indoor patient in male Surgical Ward and was treated as an indoor patient.
10. That, after his discharge, complainant had on number of occasions, visited Joypur P.S. to gather information about his complaint made on 08.05.2018 but all the time he was send back with prevaricating pleas.
11. That the complainant on query, could also gathered that no F.I.R. over his complaint had been received at the G.R. Section.
12. That, the complainant had thereafter submitted a written representation in the office of the S.P. Purulia on 09.07.2018, but no positive response has been received.
