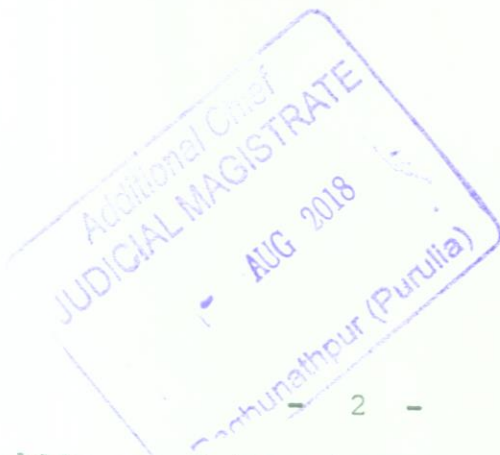

Most respectfully sheweth :-

1. That, your petitioner happens to be the legally married wife of accused No.1. The marriage between them was solemnised on 26/07/2011 at the father's house of the petitioner at Village- Nadiha, P.S.- Para, District- Purulia
2. That, the said marriage was a negotiated one and was held and performed with due observance of all the rites and rituals prevalent in their community.
3. That, at the time of marriage pursuant to the demand so made on the side of the accused the father of the

petitioner had to arrange and pay a sum of Rs. 2,00,000/- in cash to the latter. Besides gold ornaments weighing about 7 (seven) bhories had to be given to the petitioner as her stridhan properties.

4. That, your petitioner thereafter stepped into the threshold of her matrimonial house with a lot of hopes and dreams locked in her heart towards leading a happy conjugal life with accused no. 1 amidst other inmates (rest of the accused).

5. That, on the following day of the Boubhat ceremony the mother-in-law of the petitioner namely accused No.3 asked the petitioner to hand over all her gold ornaments to her on the plea of security reason and the petitioner did so in pursuance thereof. Subsequently those were never returned to the petitioner and whenever the petitioner asked for return of her stridhan (gold ornaments) all the accused in unison used to let her know that all of her stridhan have been sold out so the petitioner must stop talking about those ornaments and better to forget.

6. That, your petitioner had been subjected to mental as well as physical torture since after her marriage so meted out to her by all the accused following which she became compelled to report the matter to Hirapur P.S. but through the intervention of the relatives of the father's house of the petitioner and the Police Personnel of the P.S. the matter was settled amicably as the accused persons promised not to inflict torture upon the petitioner any further.

7. That, even thereafter torture upon the petitioner continued and that was on the rise day by day. In the meantime the petitioner gave birth to a female baby. The petitioner brooked all such torture in anticipation of perspective happiness thinking of a change in the behavioural pattern of the accused at the advent of the new born but that too proved futile.

8. The father of the petitioner had to pay a sum of Rs. 1,50,000/- (Rupees one lac fifty thousand) to the accused to meet the further demand of the latter.

That, a torture remained unabated upon the petitioner as she discovered that accused No.1 had developed extra-marital relation with one Kuheli Dasgupta, w/o Deepanjan Dasgupta whose father's house is at Burnpur and the petitioner whenever tried to convince the accused No.1 to sever the immoral relationship with said Kuheli the said approach on the side of the petitioner added fuel to the flames of all the accused.

9. That, thereafter last on 29/04/2018 at about 5.30/6.00 p.m. all the accused persons with a premeditated plan started inflicting severe physical torture upon the petitioner following which she sustained bleeding injuries on her person and started vomiting time and again. She, however, managed to contact her father's house over Cellphone intimating the incident of such assault upon her by the accused conjointly. The parents of the petitioner accompanied by other members of the
