Subject: Reporting of repeated thefts of solar modules cables at Chharrah 10 MW solar power plant site
Ref: LOA SPGD/Chharrah/55/25 dated 06.09.2016 from WBSEDEL, Kolkata for EPC execution of 10 MW(AC) solar power plant at Chharrah

With reference to the above-referred LOA of M/s WBSEDCL, BHEL is executing on EPC basis the 10 MW Solar PV Power plant at Chharrah site, Purulia, West Bengal for M/s. WBSEDCL. The plant is in operation.

BHEL has been facing repeated thefts of the laid solar modules cables at the site. The details of the dates and quantity of cables cutting and thefts are as below:

BHEL has taken various precautions for preventing thefts as (i) Providing temporary lighting in the array field and also (ii) by arranging for patrolling by police personnel at night. But still the thefts are continuing unabated. In this way the entire solar array cables will be affected.

We request you to investigate into the case as it is not an isolated incident but occurring regularly at this Chharni site and so far there has been theft incidents of more than 30 SMB boxes cables. This type of theft is not only affecting the energy generated to the electricity grid but is an irreparable loss to the solar plant belonging to WBSEDCL (of WEST BENGAL state).
