The above name complainant has to state as follows:

- 1) That the complainant is the legally married wife of the accused no-1 and their marriage was solemnized on 08/06/2018 corresponding to 3<sup>rd</sup> Ashar 1425 B.S. a per Hindu Rites and Customs as prevalent in their community and also by observing the formalities like putting on vermillion, exchange of garlands, Homa etc and the said marriage is still subsisting.
- 2) That prior to the said marriage the accused no-1 approached the complainant that he would marry her and for lastly such approach there was a love affair in between the parties for a pretty long time. And thereafter, with the consent of both the guardians' one agreement paper was executed by them and prior to that on 13/06/2018 the parties have submitted one application before the Marriage Officer for registered of their marriage with the accused no-1.
- 3) That on 08/06/2018 the complainant went to her matrimonial house at village- and P.O. Bansia, P.S. Kenda,



and started to reside therein with the accused person no-1 as husband and wife along with other accused persons. After five days of the said marriage the accused persons disclosed that as the father of the complainant did not pay any cash or kinds so the father of the complainant had to pay as cash of Rs. 1,00,000/- along with golden and silver ornaments along with other articles. Contrary to that they (accused persons) would not allowed the complainant to stay in their house. the complainant , However, reported to her father when her father stated that as he is poor have been giving at least six month time for manage of the said money, thereafter the complainant and her husband going to the house of the complainant for observing Astamangala ceremony.

- 4) That after observing Astamangala ceremony left the paternal house of the complainant in a very still thing manner i.e. without any informing to anyone. As the house of the accused no-1 also within the same village for that the complainant and her family members never taken the matter exceptional and they take that the accused no-1 would come to her house for taking back the complainant to his house for leading happy conjugal life. But since

thereafter neither the accused no-1 nor his inmates did not have taken back to the complainant to their house.

- 5) That while the complainant was at her matrimonial house, while it was very short span of time, but within the said short time the accused persons with a common intention inflicted both physical and mental upon the complainant and they also assaulted the complainant without any fault and also not provided proper food and clothing and have declared that unless the said demand will be fulfilled by the father of the complainant she will not be allowed to enter in to their house and to stay as husband and wife.
- 6) That the dream of the complainant has been broken in to pieces within 10 days from the date of her marriage and she was subjected physical as well as mental torture upon her and also assaulted by the accused persons and also not providing proper food and clothing etc.
- 7) That the inmates of the family and well wishers tried to convince the accused persons to keep the complainant in their house as husband and wife but the accused persons renewed their previous activity and flatly denied to keep the complainant in to their house. They also disclosed that they will again arrange 2<sup>nd</sup> marriage of the said Surajit

Mahato with another fair lady as the complainant is not looking so fair etc. as they stated.

- 8) That though the incident / matter was reported to the officer-in-charge of local P.S. and when no legal action was taken by the said Police then another complaint was lodged to the Superintendent of Police Purulia but same fate. Hence, the complainant is under compelling circumstance filed this complaint before this Ld. Court under the law.

In the circumstances it is therefore, prayed that your honour may be pleased to send the petition of complaint to the Officer-in-charge, Kenda P.S. treating the same as FIR under section 156(3) for investigation .
