2. That accused no.1 is the husband, accused no.2 is the father in law, accused no.3 is the mother in law accused no.4 is the Ehamour (brother in law) accused no.5 is the wife of accused no.4.

1. That since after one month from the date of marriage dispute cropped up relating to give legal status to the petitioner as the petitioner put pressure to the accused no.1 and other to registered the marriage before the marriage authority but the opp.party/accused applied various tricks to lags the time for his own accord and ultimately petitioner informed the matter before the Mankazar P.M. and on 18.8.2010 by the intervention of the police with help of village people a written compromised held between the petitioner and opp.party/accused where accused gave a promise to keep the petitioner well but after few days opp.party/accused alongwith other family members started physical as well as mental torture upon the petitioner which was unbearable to the petitioner.

2. That, being no other alternative petitioner came back to her father's house on 5.9.2010 and since then petitioner residing at her father's house at Vill. Sisaykhetpur under P.M., Mankazar, Dist. Purulia without any connection with the accused no.1.

3. That, recently in the month of August, petitioner came to know that accused no.1 started to develop physical relationship with another girl namely Mamata Mahato j/o Krishan Mahato of Vill. Mallikdanga, P.O. Anandchhatra, P.S. Ramtanah, Dist. Bankura, which is very much illegal and injustice to the petitioner.

4. That, the petitioner is a deserted lady forced to reside at her parents house by the accused without

providing any food, cloths as well medicine and the petitioner posted her case by the party of the villagers and petitioner have no capacity to lodged the case and contact the same by her own capacity as such complaint, 150(3) Cr.P.C. is required.

7. That a subsequently petitioner approached her father UNKNOWN the matter before the Magistrate P.S. but as the P.S. compromised the matter previously as such denied to accept the written complaint and your petitioner informed the matter to the Magistrate through written complaint out of no good.

It is therefore prayed that your Honour may graciously be pleased to direct the police of Mankavat P.S. to treat this petition as P.I.M. and to cause investigation in respect of the alleged incident for the end of justice.
