Dist. Purnia has committed theft of electricity u/s 135(1)(b) of the Electricity
(Amendment) Act 2007.

On dated 04-12-18 at about 1.45 P.M., I Sri Suman Mandal, Inspector
Manbazar CC, WBSECL alongwith Prasad Kumar Mishra, Manbazar CC and
Anand, Bero P.S., Manbazar CC entered the premises of Sri Gopinath Hembram
village Ukamgarh, P.S. Bero, Dist. Purnia and inspected his premises and found
that he was enjoying electricity unauthorisedly is detected. The details
of passing arrangement was damage installation and tap 2 (one) piece of
wire by which electricity directly flow to his house without energy
registration in WBSECL energy meter no-732769888 having consumption
-292159534.

During inspection theft of electricity was found if he was
using electricity unauthorisedly u/s 135(1)(b) was detected. It was
also found that he was using the following electricity equipments

- (1) one no 100 watt bulb
- (2) one no 40 watt bulb.

out of which we seized the following

- (1) one no 100 watt bulb along with 2 (one) metre pvc wire.

The Seizure list is prepared at the Site and the concerned person refused to sign in the Seizure list. The inspection team left the above premises at about 1:30 PM on dated 04-12-18. The Service Connection has been disconnected on 04-12-18.

You are requested to take cognizance of the Complaint and treat it as F.I.R. and action may be taken as per rule.
