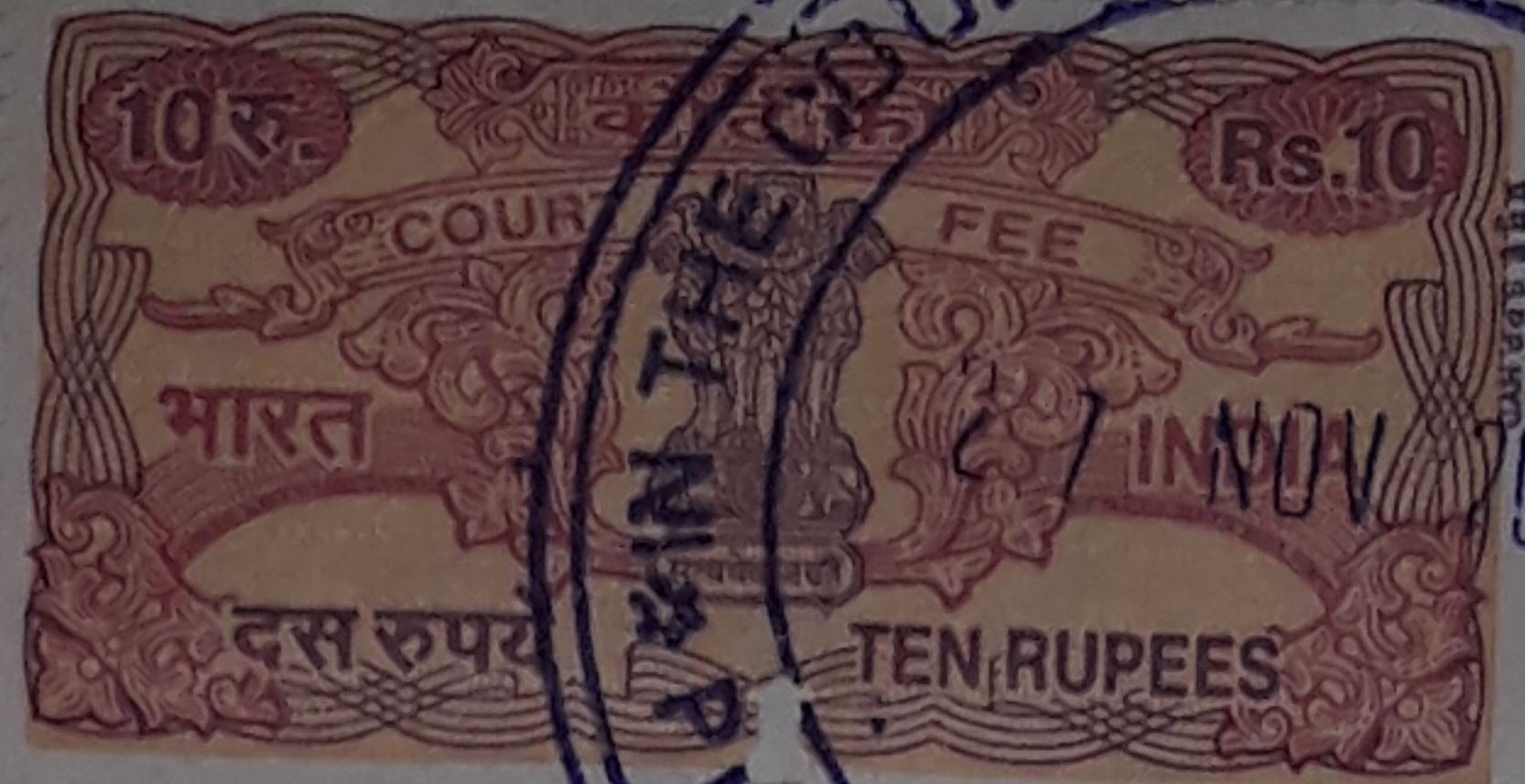

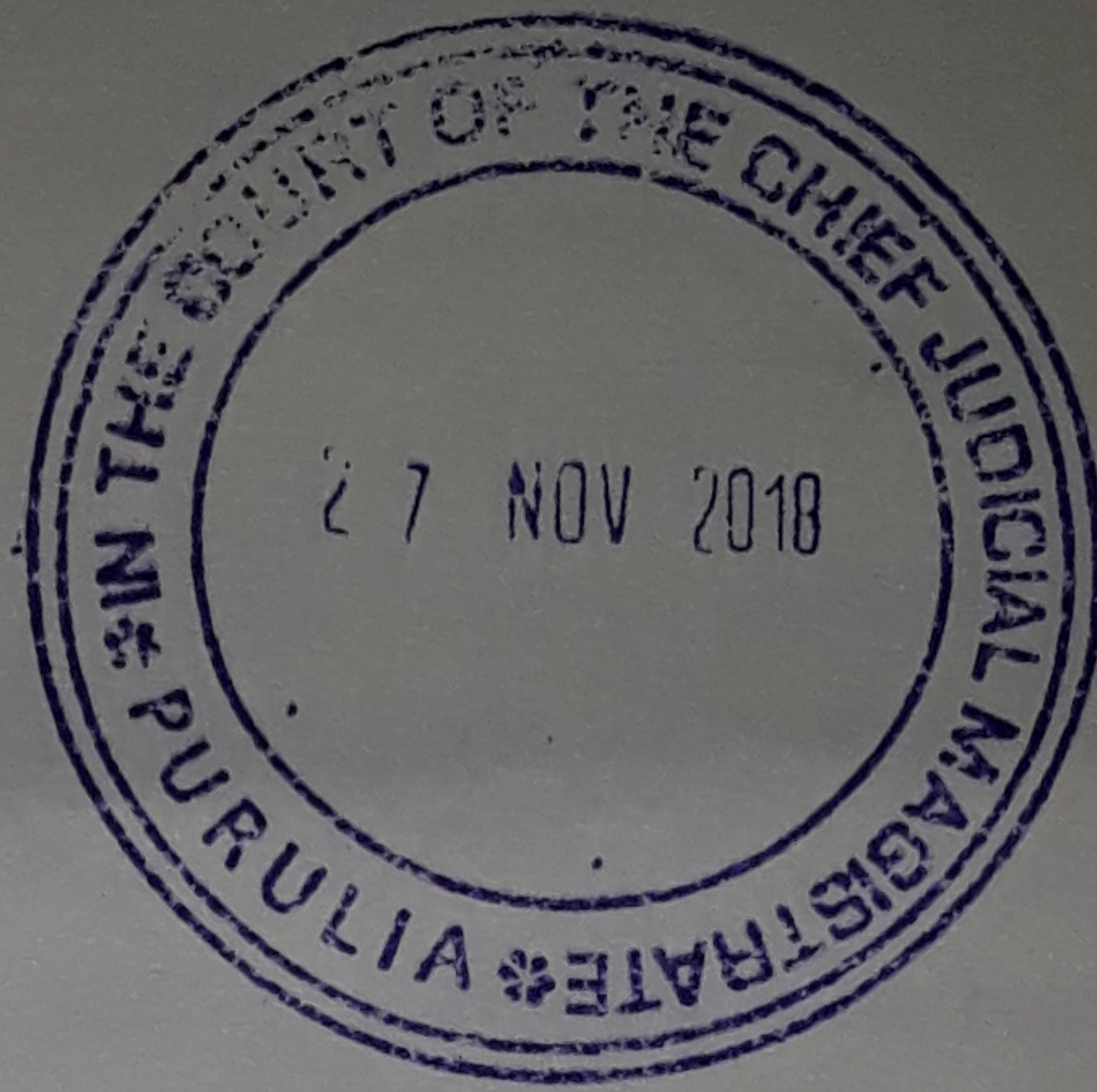

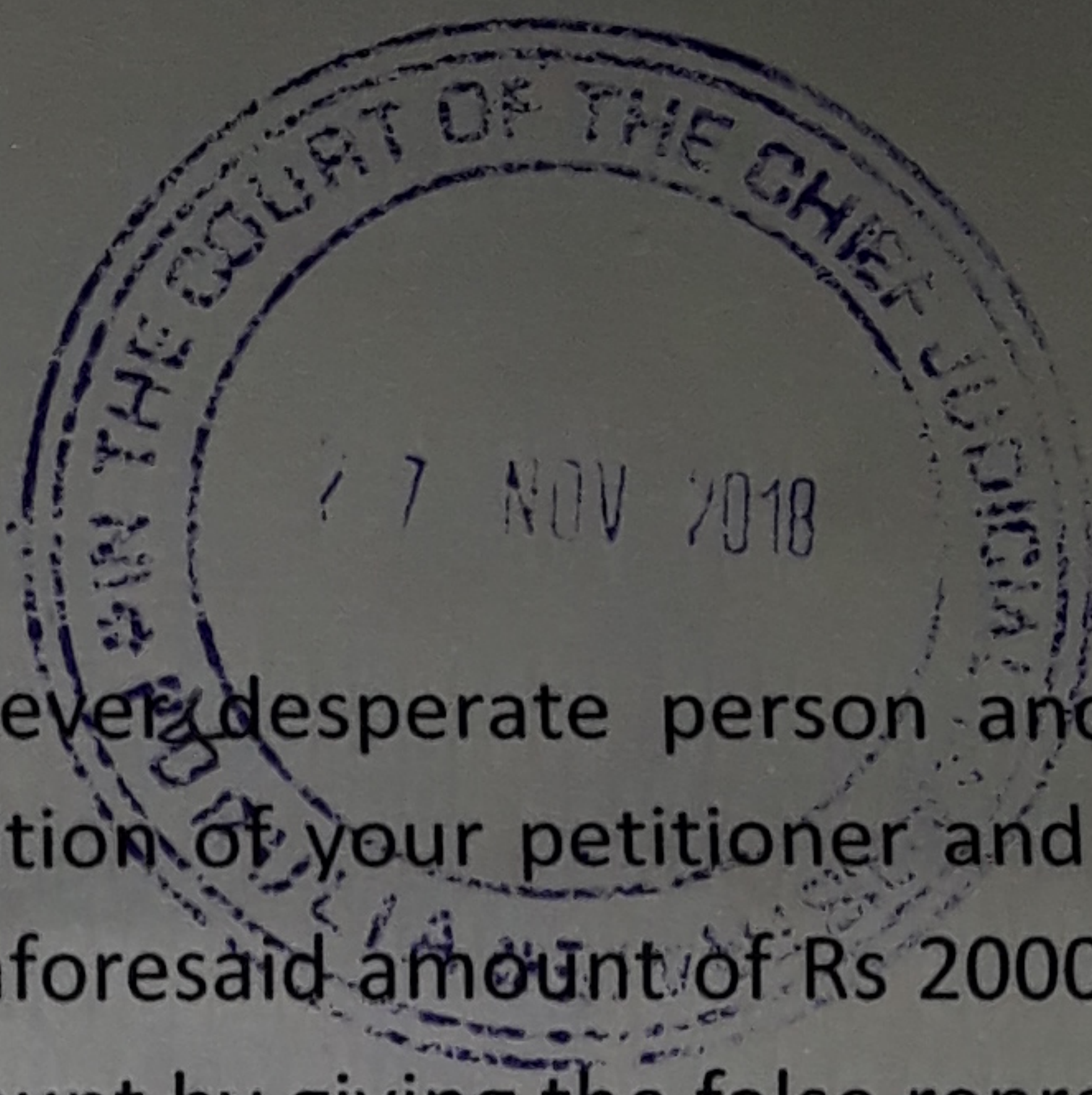

1. That your petitioner/complainant is legally married wife of one Sudin @Sudharshan Gope of Vill-Chowka, Ps-Sarikela, Dist-East-Singhbhum and their marriage had been solemnized In the year 2008 according to the customs prevail in their community.
2. That after four year the husband of the complainant namly Sudin @Sudharshan Gope died due to suffering from various ailments ,and during this four year period your petitioner gave birth two female child but after the death of her husband her father-in- law and the other members of her matrimonial house denied to take her and two children with her and they drove her with her two children in the year 2012 and since then your petitioner have no other alternative but to take shelter of her mother's house and at present she residing at her mother's house with her widowed mother as her father died long ago.
3. That in the year 2012 your petitioner met with accused Niranjn Gope of Vill-Laldih ,P.S-Baghmundi,Dist-Purulia ,and taking the opportunity of her bad situation and financial crisis he told your petitioner that he would engaged her as a daily laborer at Bengaluru as there the labor wages are high and he also motivated your petitioner that he can easily managed her family from those income as he have no source of income and totally depends on her widowed mother.
4. That your petitioner accepted the proposal of the accused and went with him to Bengaluru with the hope to given the financial support to her family.and she take the passbook of Bank of India being S/B Account No-13560, Chandil Branch(Jharkhand)in the said account she had a sum of Rs 200000/- (Rupees Two Lakh)only which she received as a compensation from the Jharkhand Government As "Damdubi"and 5 voris of Golden ornaments and some cash amount of Rs7850/- (seven thousand eight hundred and fifty)only in the year 2012 ,and the accused take her to a rented house at Bengaluru and promised her to engaged as a worker in a factory and told her that she get a handsome salary from there, and with the hope your petitioner living with her there and help the accused to all household works like cooking, cleaning etc. with a hope that the accused would engaged her in a good job at factory in Bengaluru.

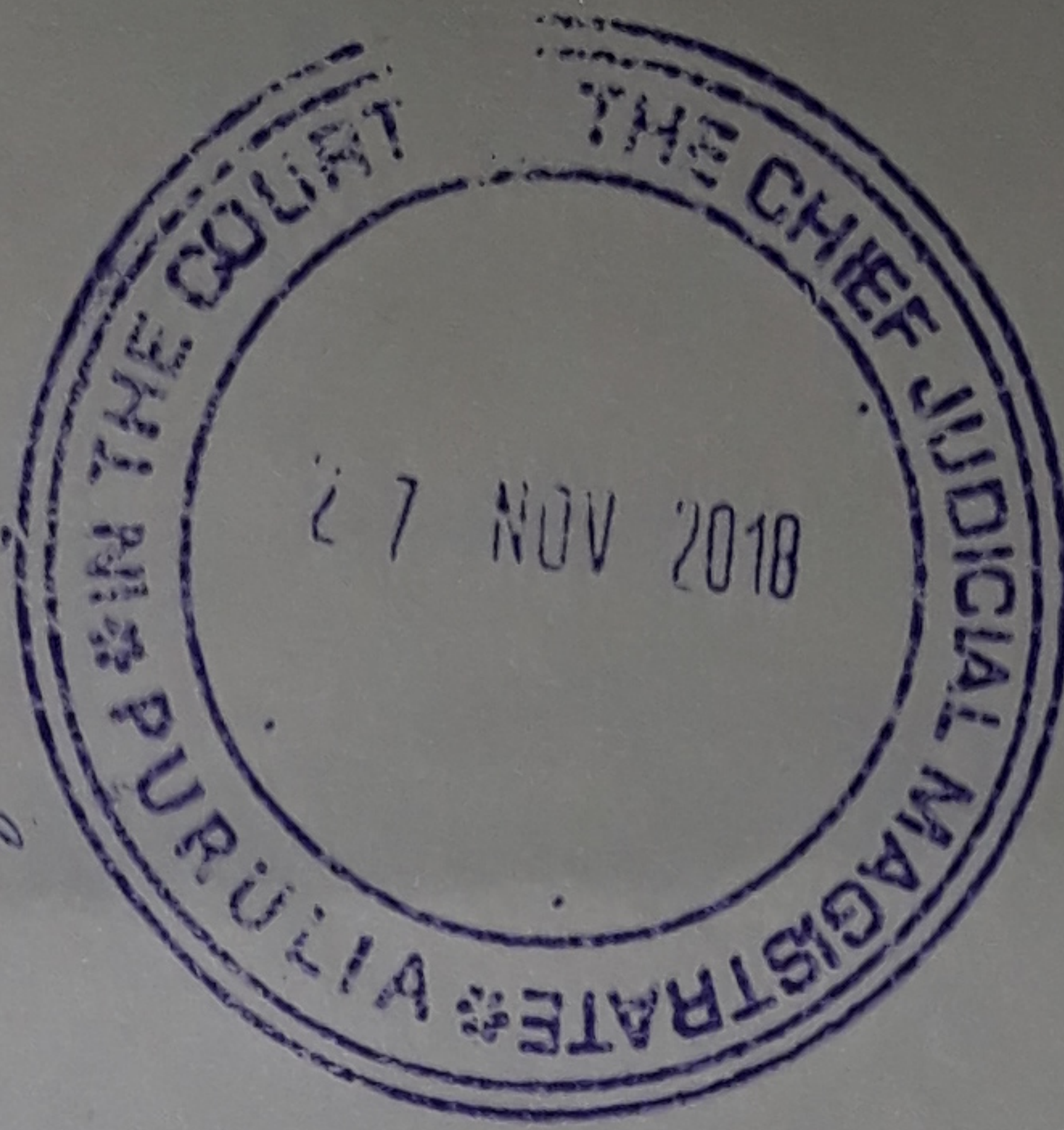

5. That the accused person is a clever & desperate person and taking the opportunity of the helpless condition of your petitioner and by giving false promises he withdrew the aforesaid amount of Rs 200000/- (Rupees two lakh) only from her Bank account by giving the false representation to your petitioner that he had badly needed the money for the treatment of his son as he was suffering from the liver problem and for the good faith your petitioner put her signature on the withdrawal slip of the Bank with a hope that the accused would return her the aforesaid money but neither the accused person returned the aforesaid money nor he engaged your petitioner as a worker in a factory, and he took back to your petitioner from Bengaluru on 10/07/2018 and dropped her at her father's house at Vill-Koradih P.S- Baghmundi and told her that he would definitely engage her and himself at a good work there and with given your petitioner such type of false promises the accused person again cheated your petitioner and asked her to take her 5 voris golden ornaments with her as he had no money as his all money became drainage for the treatment of his son and to mortgage the gold ornaments he would manage the tickets, provision of shelter and other things at Bengaluru, with a good faith your petitioner agreed to give her gold ornaments to be mortgaged for that purpose on 15/07/2018 to the accused with a hope that the accused made some arrangement for engaging her as a factory worker and gave him the golden ornaments and took Rs 5450/- from her steel trunk when your petitioner was busy with household works, the said accused person had not come to your petitioner, after five days passed your petitioner tried to call her over his mobile phone but the accused had not given any response to her.
6. That on 20/07/2018 finding no other alternatives your petitioner went to the house of the accused at Vill-Laldih, P.S-Baghmundi to ask him the probable date of their journey to Bengaluru and asked about her money and golden ornaments then the family members of the accused person were also using some filthy languages to your petitioner and the accused person assaulted your petitioner mercilessly with fist and blow and when the petitioner asked for her compensation money which the accused already had withdrawn from her account at Chandil Branch of Bank of India and 5 voris of golden ornaments, and the money which she saved at her steel trunk i.e. Rs 5450/- (Rupees five thousand four hundred and fifty) only then the accused refused to return the same to your petitioner and with the help of the family members of the accused, the accused caught her hair tightly and assaulted her with fist and blows and drove her out from his house and threatened her that if she informed anything about the money and the golden ornaments to police or

anybody the accused will killed her and told her "ja parbi kore nibi ja, kauke kichu janale mere sesh kore debo ,keo tor lashtao khuje pabe na".

7. That as there was no any chance of remedy your petitioner went to the Baghmundi P.S on 16/08/2018 and one written F.I.R. has been lodged against the accused person and concerned P.S. assured your petitioner that they will take action against the accused persons soon but did nothing and finally on 22/08/2018 the concerned P.S. advised your petitioner to take shelter of law.
8. That your petitioner filed one written complaint before the S.P Purulia on 29/08/23018 regarding the matter mentioned above and also mentioned to take action against the accused person.
9. That as the petitioner/complainant failed to get any relief from the P.S. as well as S.P. Purulia she is filling this Misc. Petition under section 156(3) Cr.P.C for reliefs as enumerated below and the accused person has been threatening to your petitioner/complainant that if she informed the matter to any where she will face the consequent, your petitioner is a poor lady with two children and a widow mother ,the aforesaid money and the golden ornaments are the only mean to survive her family with her widowed mother and your petitioner is totally dependent on her widowed mother.

It is therefore prayed that your Honour may graciously be pleased to send this petition to the O/C Baghmundi P.S. treating same as F.I.R. as per sec. 156(3) Cr.p.c. For the ends of justice.
