## Facts of the case:-

The above named complainant

## Begs to state as follows:-

- That the complainant and the accused persons are the permanent resident of village Khayerbani within P.S.-Boro which is within the jurisdiction of this Court.
- 2. That the complainant after taking the land as per the request of Lakhiram Soren in the year 1417 and Naran Hembram in the year 2011 after paying of Rs. \$ 000/- and 6,000/- respectively and stated cultivation within their lands.
- That the complainant also grown paddy over the lands which he was allotted to cultivate from those two persons who took money from the complainant.
- 4. That on 10/09/2018 at 12:00 noon the complainant was inside of his house and he hearing the roaring/groaning of his bullock came out from his house and found that all the bullocks of the accused were in hitting his bullocks and the accuse assaulted the bullocks of the complainant and as a result the frontal leg of the complainant's bullock got fractured.
- 5. That when the accused were assaulting the bullocks of the complainant, he rushed to his bullocks at that relevant time the accused assaulted him by fists and bows and also by lathi and Tikaram Murmu tried to assault over his head with the help of sickle(Kaste) and as he tried to save his head the sickle hit the right hand causing bleeding injury and due to the hue and cry of the complainant, the sons and wife of the complainant as well as the neighbours(Para People) assembled there and after abusing the complainant and also threatening him to kill the accused left the place.

- 6. That thereafter the complainant with his son went to the Boro P.S. and the police advised him for treating the injuries at first.
- 7. That the complainant thereafter lodged complaint at Boro P.S. but the police did not take any step.
- 8. That the accused persons stated various tortures upon the complainant and even they cut away the paddy on 16/11/2018 at 12:00 in the mid day from the lands which he got after paying Rs.-5,000/- from Lakhiram Soren and Rs.-6,000/- from Naran Hembram for which an information was lodged on that day.
- 9. That the accused are more in numbers in the small village got this complainant boycotted and did not allow him to use the tank and the tube well or well of which the information was lodged on 21/12/2018 and the police of Boro P.S. asked the complainant to attend the P.S. on 24/12/2018 and further told that the accused persons are also have been directed to attend the P.S..
- 10. That on that day i.e., 24/12/2018 at about 01:00 noon when the complainant returned from the P.S. the police directed the complainant to meet with him to compromise the dispute through Sovaram Murmu, the husband of the Panchayat Samity member and on 25/12/2018 at 09:00 morning as per the instruction of the police as well as Sovaram the complainant met with Sovaram and he directed him to put his signature in a blank white paper and he directed him to pay Rs. 100/- and leave the place.
- 11. That due to the breaking of the leg of the bullock of the complainant, he sustained a loss of Rs. 35,000/- due to the useless of the bullock and further sustained the loss of Rs. 6,000/- for taking away the paddy and also sustained the bleeding injuries on his hand for which the accused persons have committed offence of sections 379/324/148/149/429/506 I.P.C.
- 12. That the police of Boro P.S. did not take any step or start any case against the accused persons for which the complainant informed to the S.P. of Purulia on 27/12/2018 but as neither the S.P. nor the O.C. stated any case against the accused persons for which the complainant has been compelled to file this case/petition 156(3) of Cr.P.Code before the Learned Courte.

It is, therefore, prayed that your Honour be graciously pleased to pass an order to send this petition to O.C. Boro P.S. to investigate the facts of the case treating this petition as F.I.R. and to submit report before the Learned Court.
