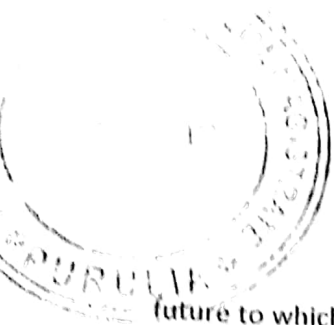

**In the matter of an application u/s 156 (3) Cr.P.C.**

The Complainant named above begs to state as follows:-

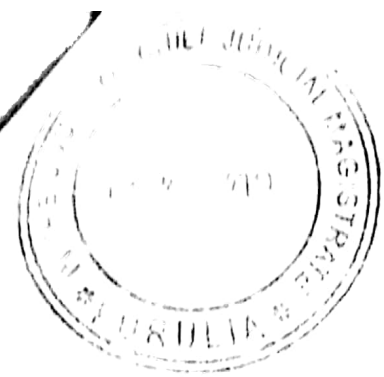
- 1) That the Complainant is the unfortunate father of one Haladhar Kumar (since deceased).
- 2) That said Late Haladhar Kumar was married with the Accused no-1 Smt. Ritu Kumar, d/o Mona @ Manoranjan Kumar few years ago.
- 3) That on the persistent pressure of said Ritu Kumar, her husband Haladhar Kumar was compelled to get themselves separated in mess from his parents. *but the two families were in visiting term.*
- 4) That said Haladhar Kumar was a Carpenter by profession and for his profession he had to go out of station off and on.
- 5) That the Complainant and his wife noticed that since some time past, said Ritu Kumar developed an extra marital relationship with the Accused no-2 Sri Haren Kumar of the same village and over the issue there was often hot talks between said Ritu Kumar and Haladhar Kumar.
- 6) That the Complainant and the witness <sup>2,</sup> ~~no 3~~ and 4 on many occasions found the Accused no-1 and 2 in various compromising situation and to embrace each other in absence of Haladhar Kumar i.e. the husband of the Accused no-1.
- 7) That when the extra marital relationship between the Accused Persons exceeded the limit, the Complainant once called the Accused no-2 and protested against his such acts and forbid him to do any such illegal act ever in

- future to which the Accused no-2 threatened him that if the Complainant again tries to be a hurdle in their affairs, he will be taught a good lesson which may extend up to murder.
- 8) That the Complainant thereafter brought the matter into the notice of his son Haladhar Kumar who instantly blamed his wife.
  - 9) That on 16/01/2019 at about 9.00 p.m. the Complainant heard that a hot altercation was going on between his son Haladhar Kumar and the Accused no-1 over the issue of the very extra marital affairs.
  - 10) That on the next day i.e. 17/01/2019 the Complainant and his family members noticed that on that date Haladhar did not go to his work but remained in the house and it was also noticed that almost all the day there were incidents of quarrel between the couple over the self and same matter and even in the evening of the day the same altercation recurred.
  - 11) That on the next morning i.e. on 18/01/2019 at about 6.00 a.m. there was a commotion in the village that a dead body is lying by the side of the railway track near Mosina village and in between Jhalda and Tulin railway station.
  - 12) That out of curiosity the witness no-2 Durgacharan Kumar, who happens to be the son of the Complainant, rushed to the <sup>place</sup> and found GRPS Officers and many other persons present there.
  - 13) That seeing the dead body, said Durgacharan Kumar identified the corpse to be of his full brother Haladhar Kumar and disclosed the same to the GRPS Officers and at that time said Durga Charan Kumar also narrated the entire story behind the screen to that GRPS Officer who stated him to take the matter to Jhalda P.S. for starting a specific case.
  - 14) That the GRPS officers then lifted the dead body from the spot and sent the same to the Purulia Deben Mahato Sadar Hospital for P.M. and asked the son of the Complainant i.e. the witness no-2 to go to the Hospital for collecting the dead body after P.M.Examination.
  - 15) That Durgacharan thereafter hurriedly went back to his house and reported the matter to the Complainant and his other family members.
  - 16) That soon after the commotion in the village, the Accused no-2 Haren Kumar fled away from his residence and remained out of station for few days.
  - 17) That the Complainant has got no doubt and is sure enough that his daughter-in-law and said Haren Kumar i.e. the Accused no-1 and 2 have caused the murder of said Haladhar Kumar sometime within the night of 17/01/2019 and

- the early morning of 18/01/2019 with intent to eliminate the only barrier on the way of their extra marital relationship and have thrown the dead body by the side of the Railway Track to show the matter to be an accidental case.
- 18) That the Complainant immediately informed the matter to Jhalda P.S. who did not take his Complaint and stated him that the body was recovered by GRPS from the side of the Railway Track, so the Complainant will have to go to the GRPS for any relief and reliefs whatsoever.
- 19) That the Complainant then sent a Written Complaint under Registered Post with A/D to the I.C. Jhalda P.S. and also brought the matter into the notice of the S.P, Purulia but for no good. None of the police authorities have taken any step against the Accused Persons.
- 20) That the matter involves search, seizure and examination of witnesses which could not be possible without the interference of police and without any investigation whatsoever and as such the Complainant is being compelled to lodged this Petition u/s 156(3) Cr.P.C. before Your Honour's Court.

In the circumstances stated above, it is prayed that Your Honour may be graciously pleased to send this Complaint to the I. C. Jhalda P.S. with a direction to treat the same as F.I.R. and to start investigation in the matter and to prosecute the Accused Persons as per law.
