The humble petition U/S 156 (3) of the Code of Criminal Procedure 1973 on behalf of the petitioner above named;

Most respectfully begs to state:

- 1. That the petitioner is legally married wife of the accused No. 1 which is still subsisting between them.
- 2. That the marriage of the petitioner with the accused No. 1 Rintu Sao was a negotiated one and was solemnized on 25th February 2012 at "Chabibiri Dharmashala" and the same was registered before Hindu Marriage Registrar, Purulia on 07/06/2012. At the time of marriage the father of the petitioner, to meet up with the demand from the accused No. 1 and other in-laws gave Rs. 2,00,000/- and other articles like 4 bhories of gold ornaments, utensils of brass and bell metals to the accused No.1 to meet up the dowry demand of the accused persons.
- 3. That after the marriage the petitioner along with those articles went to her matrimonial home at Jail-khana More within Purulia (T) and started






residing with the accused persons under the common roof. The accused No. 1 at the relevant point of time was an Asst. Teacher of Dahijuri High School, Jhargram, and he used to come to my matrimonial house in the weekends.

- 4. That the in-laws of the petitioner named above were not satisfied with the dowry articles and they started mocking at her regarding the quality of those articles and had asked her to tell her father to pay Rs. 10,00,000/- to meet up further demand and when she had refuse to tell the same to her father they started abusing her and treating me badly. the petitioner had reported the matter to her husband but he remained indifferent and asked the petitioner to adjust with them. This state of affairs had continue for about six months and at that time the petitioner became pregnant and the Doctor had advise to take complete bed rest and as there is none to look after the petitioner and she had to take shelter at her father's place.
- 5. That on 11/6/13 the petitioner gave birth to a girl child, namely Ishani Shaw at K.M. memorial Hospital, Bokaro and the father of the petitioner had to bear all the medical expenses and two month thereafter the petitioner had joined her matrimonial home but the accused persons were not happy and started abusing her for giving birth to a girl child







and at times her husband and other in laws resorted to physical assault to the petitioner. The accused persons never took any care of the baby. Having no other alternative the petitioner came back to her parent's house, neither the husband of the petitioner nor rest of the accused ever came to see neither the petitioner nor her daughter. In the mean time the accused No. 1 was transferred to Kantadih Siksa Satra High School, Arsha, Purulia, in the month of July 2017 but till then he did not care to take any information of the petitioner or the child.

- 6. That in the month of February 2018, the accused No. 1 called the brother of the petitioner and disclosed that he could realize his mistake and proposed to stay with the petitioner with my daughter at a separate accommodation.
- 7. That the accused No. 1 took an apartment on rent at Roshan Plaza, opposite to Syndicate Bank, being flat no. 401 in the 4th Floor and the petitioner and her daughter had joined the accused No. 1.
- 8. That few days thereafter the accused No.1 again started picking up quarrel with the petitioner over trifles and rest of the accused persons frequently started visiting that flat and they and the accused No.1 started demanding rupees 10,00,000/- as the petitioner had given birth



to a female child. When the petitioner had refused to do so, the accused No. 1 and others used to inflict physical as well mental torture and all these lead the petitioner to think of committing suicide, but considering the condition of her child she had restrained herself from doing so.

- That the petitioner had to do all the daily work for the household after completion of her job in the Bank. The accused No.1 had pressurized the petitioner to withdraw money from my account.
- 10. That on 30.12.2018, the friends and family of my accused No.1 had arranged for a picnic at "Poprakoncha Dam" and the accused No. 1 was not inclined to take the petitioner there but as his friends and their family members had requested him to take the petitioner and her daughter, he ultimately took us. But at the picnic spot misbehaved and insulted the petitioner.
- 11. That on 31.12.2018, after her return to the flat from her bank, the petitioner found that the locks of the main door were changed and she could not enter into the flat and all of her personal effects are lying there (a list of the main items is given). The petitioner had made calls to her husband and the accused persons, to which they did not respond, ultimately she went to my father's house at Sarat Sen Compound, as her father used to take her daughter from the schools. Around 8 pm all the



accused persons along with others gathered in front of the father's house of the petitioner with lathi, rod etc and attempted to break the doors. The matter was reported to Purulia Town P.S over phone and after the arrival of the police they had stopped and it was decided that the matter would be resolved at police station on the next day.

- 12. That on the next day, the accused persons did not appear personally and they took time to resolve the matter. Later they did not turn up. All the personal effects of the petitioner are lying inside the said flat and without police help there could not be recovered.
- 13. That the local P.S had refused to take any steps. The matter was reported to the Superintendent of Police, Purulia on 11.1.2019, but no steps till date was taken.
- 14. That in the meantime, on 22.1.2019 the father of the accused No. 1 passed away, the petitioner made all endeavor to resolve the matter, and even attended the gathering, but the accused persons remained unturned.
