1---- That your petitioner is legally married wife of accused Sanatan Majhi .The parties are Santal by caste and Hindu by religion . Their marriage was solemnised on 11-03-2013 corresponding to 27th. Falgun 1419 B.S. , according to their customary rite and formalities prevalent in their community in presence of Chhutu Majhi, Thakurdas Majhi ,Nakul Majhi. Kharu Majhi was the Raibangshi @ Ghatak in the marriage . Their marriage was duly consummated and out of their wed lock a female child is born to them .The marriage tie between the petitioner and Sanatan Majhi still subsists .

2----That at the time of marriage , her mother had to give considerable dowry including a hard cash of Rs. 50,000/- Utensils etc.to accused Sanatan Majhi and his other inmates after selling cultivable land but they were not satisfied with the same .

3----That after marriage , your petitioner been to her matrimonial home and started living therein as husband and wife for about one year or so gave birth to female child . At this, her husband and other inmates of her matrimonial members were very much astonished . According to her matrimonial members birth of a female baby in the family is a curse .After the birth of the female child her husband and his other family members jointly started a fresh demand of Rs. 10,000/- from her poor mother which could not be fulfilled by her poor mother and for that her husband Sanatan Majhi , S/O Sri Nikhil Majhi , parent in law Nikhil Majhi and Ramani Majhi , Gunadhar Majhi (Dewar) son of Nikhil Majhi, Sombari Majhi (Nanad) D/O Sri Nikhil Majhi jointly started mental and physical torture, cruelties, harassment and assault upon your petitioner and spoke out that her husband would contract second marriage with another girl which would ensure them further lucrative dowry . They also threatened that if their

demand of Rs. 10,000/- is not bring from her mother in that event she would have no place in their house .

4---That since her poor mother could not fulfil the fresh demand at this, she was subjected to mental and physical torture by the accused persons in various false pretexts . Being the devoted wife she had to tolerate all the humiliation , harassment , mental and physical torture, assault and cruelties exercised upon her by the matrimonial members on the hope that her husband and other accused persons would mend themselves and would be normal towards her but her hope was never materialised. , Day by day torture and assault were gradually increased upon her which is beyond description . She was denied bare necessities of life , refused to keep in the matrimonial home by her husband and others . Her mother in law did not allow her to enter in the bed room of accused Sanatan Majhi . Of and on she was drove out by her husband after assault at the direct instigation of her other in laws i.e. the accused persons .

5---That it may be mentioned here that during her stay in the matrimonial home , she detected that her husband has developed illicit relation with a girl and off and on he was eloped elsewhere with that girl . When the petitioner requested her husband to leave the company of that girl and lead happy conjugal life with her at this, her husband started to assault her mercilessly and silenced her with dire consequences and asked to go her paternal house and commit suicide there and drove her out from the matrimonial house on 30-03-2019 .

6---Thereafter my poor mother reached the petitioner to her matrimonial house and request the accused persons to keep the petitioner and her daughter . Her husband unwillingly keep the petitioner and her minor daughter but after 3 / 4 days he again started to assault petitioner as before .

7---That thereafter waiting for some times mother of the petitioner again reached her to her matrimonial home but the petitioner was behaved with cruelty by all accused persons did not allow her to enter the house and flatly spoke out that they did not want to see the petitioner any more and shut the door of the house and advised her to commit suicide . Thereafter the petitioner and her minor child came back to her mother`s house with disappointed what to do or not .

8---That your petitioner has informed all about her ordeal faced by her in the matrimonial home before the local police station but the concerned police station was found evasive in the matter best known to them . finding no other alternative your petitioner knocked the door of the Superintendent of Police Purulia on 18-04-2019, but it is a matter of regret that nothing has been done from his good office .

9---That your petitioner is a helpless , deserted and destitute woman having no source of income . She is in acute distress and poverty and not in a position to conduct the case in her own costs. More over there are some legal and technical aspect involved in the matter which can be responded in a complaint oriented case . So a thorough police investigation is required in the matter .

In view of the circumstances , it is prayed that your honour may be graciously pleased to direct the O/C Balarampur P.S. to investigate the case according to law , treating the same as F.I.R . as contemplated U/S 156(3) Cr.P.C.
