Most respectfully begs to submit as follows:-

1. That the petitioner is the legally married wife of the Opp. Party No.1 Prashanta Kalindi,
2. That marriage in between the petitioner and the opp. party No.1 was solemnised on 14-3-2015 according to Hindu rites and custom prevalent in their community.
3. That at the time of marriage the father of the petitioner has given Rs.3,00,000/- as dowry money to the opp. party members as per their demands, and gold and silver ornaments and other household articles were also given to the opp. party members.
4. That after marriage the petitioner went to her matrimonial house at Village-Berma and lived with the opp. party No.1 as husband and wife .

5. That out their wed-lock a male child was born who is aged about 3 years.
6. That since after marriage the opp.party members started torture upon the petitioner both physically and mentally, and they also did not provide sufficient food, clothings and other essentials to the petitioner. The opp.party ~~members~~ 2,3 and 4 instigated the opp.party No.1 to assault the petitioner Sachita Kalindi. The opp.party No.1 on his turn assaulted the petitioner mercilessly and lastly drove her from her matrimonial house.
7. That having no other alternative the petitioner ~~took~~ took shelter to his father and till date she is residing at her father's house .
8. That the opp.party No.1 filed a Matrimonial suit being No. 66 of 2016 before the Court of the Ld.District Judge, Purulia and now the said matrimonial suit is pending in the Court of the Ld.Addl.Dist.Judge-3, Purulia.
9. That the petitioner learnt from reliable source on 22-6-2019 in connivance with other opp.party members that the opp.party No.1 has married for the second time to a girl probably the resident of Village-Tentle and committed the offence of Bigamy.
10. That the opp.party members have committed the offence U/S ~~§~~ 498A/494/34 of I.P.C. and Section 3/4 of Dowry Prohibition Act.

Under the aforesaid circumstances the petitioner prays for starting a specific case U/S 498A/494/34 of I.P.C. & Section 3/4 of Dowry Prohibition Act. against the opp.party members.
