



The complainant above named begs to state as follows:-

1. That the complainant is the legally married wife of accused no. 1 Tapan Paramanik and their marriage was solemnised on 12.5.2017 according to their customary rites and formalities prevailing in their community. The parties are Hindu by religion and their marriage was duly consummated. The marital tie between them is still subsisting. After marriage the complainant went to her matrimonial home and there they lived together as husband and wife.
2. That the complainant is the legally married wife of accused no. 1 , other accused persons are her close relation such as father-in-law 'Bhasur' and Ja, practically accused no. 4 is the head of the family and her words are the last word in the family.

3. That after marriage the complainant went to her matrimonial home to discharge her matrimonial life and due to such wed lock the complainant gave birth of a daughter.
4. That at the time of marriage the father of the complainant gave Rs,60,000/= furnitures, utensiles and golden ornament of two bhories and khatia to the accused persons as per their demand.
5. That after few months of marriage the accused persons started to torture upon the complainant by physically and mentally and they put pressure upon her to bring Rs,5000/= as further ~~as~~ dowry which complainant's father could not fulfill.
6. That the facts of ill treatment, torture and assault upon the complainant gradually increasing. The accused persons assaulted the complainant mercilessly and the supply of food was very irregular and even small quantity and started to torture upon the complainant by various ways both mentally and physically.
7. That ~~mixx~~ even after bearing impersistent torture the petitioner/complainant gave birth of a female child, so the husband of the complainant and others accused persons became angry and they started to inhuman torture upon the complainant became pregnant after few months of marriage, at the time

at the time ~~of~~ all the accused persons assaulted the complainant by fist and blow on her abdomen and different parts of her body and as a result of which the pregnancy of the complainant was aborted. Thereafter complainant gave birth of female baby namely Mou Paramanik she is now aged about 7 months

8. That after birth of said female child the accused persons started to assault the complainant mercilessly in every days and on 25.11.2018 all the accused persons assaulted the ~~wife~~ complainant mercilessly and they forcibly drove her from their house. The complainant has been compelled to take shelter ~~in~~ in her father's house and she reported the matter to the O/C Purulia(Town) p.s. Thereafter ⁱⁿ compromise the accused persons took her in their house and they gave undertaking that they will not make any sort of torture upon the complainant in future.

10. That thereafter the accused persons took her at village Raghabpur and they used to live together as husband and wife in a rental house of Bina Chakraborty the witness no. 4. The accused no. 2 to 4 went the said rented house of the accused no. 1 at village Raghabpur and they ~~as~~ used to quarrel with complainant and they also used to assaulted the complainant mercilessly.

11. That lastly on 25.2019 at 11 P.M. all the accused persons went to the rental house of the complainant at village Raghapur and they started to quarrel with the complainant and they directly instigated the accused person no.1 to kill the complainant by beating her with lathi. The accused no.1 for the purpose of killing the complainant, they assaulted the complainant by lathi mercilessly and as a result of which the complainant received gravious fracture injury on her right hand and the accused no.4 forcibly pressed the neck of the complainant. The accused persons did not make her any medical treatment. Hearing the such incident the parents of the complainant came at village Raghapur and they took her at Purulia Sadar Hospital for her treatment.

12. That the complainant reported the matter to the O/C Purulia(M) p.s. in writing and she also reported the matter to o/c Purulia(M) p.s. and she also reported the matter to S.P. Purulia but police did not start any case against the accused persons. The accused no.1 is trying to marry for the 2nd times. So the complainant has been compelled to file this case before the Lt. Court.
