Sir,

With due respect and humble submission I beg to report that on 25/08/2019 at about 11.15 hrs. I along with force had been to Traffic More, Raghunathpur for workout the information that an accident taken place near Raghunathpur Plastic house.

After reaching the spot found that one dumper having Reg. No. WB45 2250 standing there and 02 (two) female dead bodies were lying on the road under the said dumper. During enquiry it transpired that just before few minutes a road accident taken place at Raghunathpur Traffic More in which the above noted dumper dashed two female persons as result both are sustained bleeding injuries on their person and succumbed on the spot. Over this Raghunathpur PS Case No 120/19 dtd 25.08.19 U/S 279/304A IPC has already been started.

On seeing such terrible accident almost 400-500 unknown persons assembled there and showed their agitation against various issue. Police were intervening into the matter to tackle the situation. During discussion some unknown mob from other side set fire on the said offending dumper having Reg. No. WB452250 as a result damaged the said dumper. As soon as I asked for reinforcement of force and also informed the fire brigade authority and immediately they came to the spot and extinguished the fire. After that a huge number of officer and force reached to the spot. On seeing the said police party the unruly mob fled away from the spot and there after we taken away the dead bodies and send them to Raghunathpur S. S Hospital. We tried our label best to arrest the person who are involved on setting fire but none could be available there. All are left the spot to evade police arrest. I tried to collect the details of the persons who are involved in this case but failed.

Therefore I lodge a suo-motu complaint against the some unknown miscreants to start a specific case. I have badly engaged in law & order duty hence delay to submit the complaint.
