Sir,

In producing here with one arrested accd namely Mahananda Hembram (35) S/O- Fagu Hembram of Bagandih, PS- Arsha, Dist- Purulia along with following seized articles as noted below-

- 1) One white colour plastic container with approx 10 ltrs of cholai,
- 2) One white colour plastic container with approx 9 ltrs of cholai.

(Approx 500 ml taken out from each of the above containers as sample packed with sealing wax)

I, ASI Bidhan Ch. Mandal of Arsha PS do hereby lodge a written complaint against the above noted accused person to the effect that today 25.09.19 at about 15:05 during my special mobile duty receive source information over telephone that the above noted accused has been selling liquor illegally and clandestinely in front of his house at Bagandih village under Arsha PS, Dist- Purulia. On receiving the reliable source information I communicated with O/C Arsha PS over telephone and as per his instruction I along with C/-628 Giridhari Bouri and C/-744 Sushanta Chakraborty of Arsha PS rushed to the spot to work out the information. Reaching at Bagandih village we fixed-up the house of above noted accd. person and noticed that the selling country spirit was going on there and getting seen of police all customers were managed to escape, but we able to apprehended the above noted accused person. On demand of papers he failed to produce any valid documents in support of selling Cholai. So I seized all the implicating articles as noted above under a proper seizure list from his exclusive possession in presence of witnesses and properly sealed and labelled duly signed by the accused persons and witnesses among which Approx 500 ml taken out from each of the above containers as sample packed with sealing wax with label. During interrogation he confessed his guilt so, I arrested him after observing all the formalities issuing memo of arrest as the accused persons are liable for prosecution u/s 46A(c) of The Bengal Excise Act,1909.

I therefore pray that a specific case may kindly be started against the accused namely Mahananda Hembram (35) S/O- Fagu Hembram of Bagandih P.S.-Arsha Dist- Purulia under proper section of law and arrange for its regular investigation.
