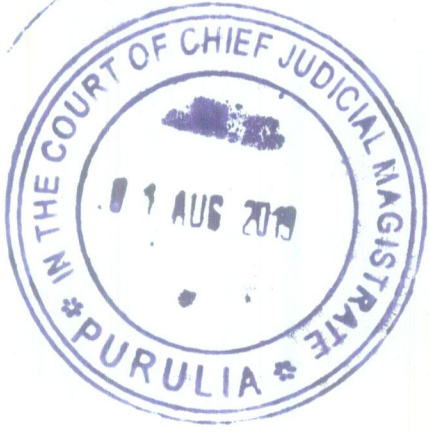

1. That your complainant is a permanent resident of Village Gohaldang, P.O.- Mudali, P.S.- Balarampur, Dist.- Purulia and within the jurisdiction of this Ld. Court.
2. That the minor daughter of your petitioner namely Jhunpuki Beda approximately aged about 17 years on dated 14.07.2019 at about 08:00 A.M. departed towards Balarampur Bansgard Hospital to visit Balarampur B.P.H.C. where her grandmother Sarubali Beda was admitted and getting treated thereon.
3. That after elapsing a considerable period the daughter of your complainant did not reach the Hospital. At this the family members of your complainant become worried and searched their level best at every possible places and came to know that one Sandip Beda, S/O Dhana Beda of village PradhanKanta, P.S. Beliapur, District Dhanbad (JH) kidnapped his minor daughter.
4. That at this thereafter your complainant approached before the house of the accused no 1 namely Sandip Beda where he inquired about her minor daughter at this the uncle (Jhatha Mosai) namely Kora Beda accd. No 2 become furious and abused and assaulted your complainant with fist and blows and threatened your complainant with dire consequences and compell to your complainant to leave the place.
5. That your complainant has every reason to believe that her minor daughter Jhunpuki Beda is being abused and exploited Sexually by the accd no 1 with the help of other accd. no 2 keeping a secrets place.

7. That the acd. person have committed the offence and they are liable to be punished accordingly.

8. That your complainant is a poor person and he has not in position to pull or conduct of the complaint case for all such reasons the police case is desirable.

It is therefore prayed that your Honour may graciously be pleased to unfold the truth, this complain petition may kindly be sent to the officer-in-charge of Balarampur P.S. to treat this written complain as F.I.R. for a thorough investigation of the same U/S- 156(3) Cr.P.C. as the life of a minor girl is at jeopardy at the present juncture for the ends of justice.
