company is engaged with broiler integration  
business.

Sri Hiralal Tudu (9641621877) s/o Sri  
Subhash Tudu vil. Alkusha, P.S. - Nituria, Purulia  
is our one of the contact farmer whom we  
supplied 2570 pc day old broiler chicks through  
challan no. 223 & 224 both dated 23/7/19 to look  
after and grow to his farm situated at Mauza - Alkusha,  
S.No - 180, P.O. No - 1888, Nituria, Purulia.

Sri Chandu Ghosh (6297383479) s/o Sri  
Mayan Ghosh of Malindasi, P.S. Dist - Bankura was  
our company employee and responsible to visit  
daily the all farms of Alkusha, Nituria, Purulia  
zone. Later due to his mis-conduct company  
terminated Chandu Ghosh on and from 23/8/19,  
to retaliate Chandu Ghosh sold out the 2286 pc  
grown birds valued Rs. 2,86,413/- (Rs. Two Lacs  
eighty six thousand four hundred thirteen) only and  
misappropriated the total birds value.

Sri Chandu made a phone call to the  
contact farmer on 27/8/19 at about 09:10 am and  
informed that company will lift the birds from  
his farm at tonight. And at about 09:40 pm  
on 27/8/19 Chandu Ghosh again made a phone call  
to the said contact farmer to confirm about birds  
lifting. At about 09:00 pm to 12:00 pm the trader made  
phone call to the said contact farmer from his mobile  
no. which ends with last three digit 401 to confirm  
that they will arrive farm after 12:00 pm to lift.

Sri Chandu Ghosh misguided the  
contact farmer Tudu that he is lifting the birds

on behalf of the company and he is responsible to issue him the lifting D.C. in next morning as it is not available on that moment.

On 28/8/19 when our newly appointed Supervisor went to the farm on usual visit he found there were only 436 birds present. He informed me over phone.

I reached the farm at about 12:00 PM and asked the contact farmer Mr. Tudu about the birds and came to know the fact.

On 28/8/19 we severally tried to contact with Chandu Ghosh over phone but his phone was switched off. Then 29/8/19 we went to his house Malindasi but he was absconded.

The accused Chandu Ghosh has cheated and misappropriated company birds value Rs. 2,86,413/- (Rs. Two Lakhs eighty six thousand four hundred thirteen, made fraud with company as well as the contact farmer Mr. Tudu.

You are hereby requested to kindly accept this complain as an FIR and to take necessary legal action.

Company Head office instruction delayed us to file the complain.
